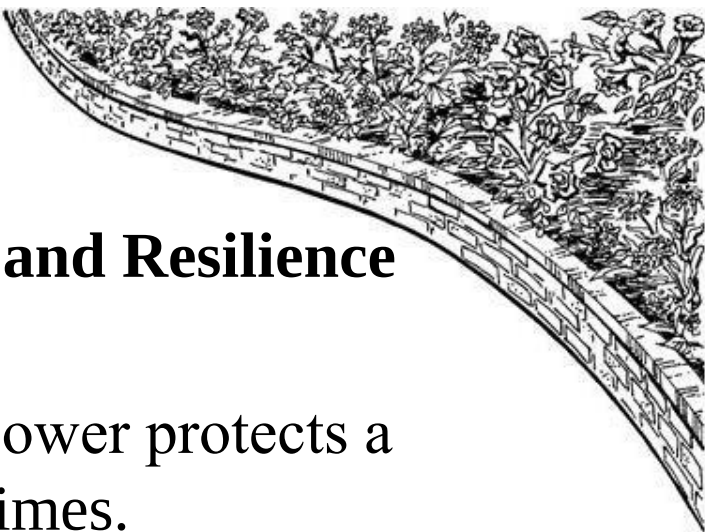
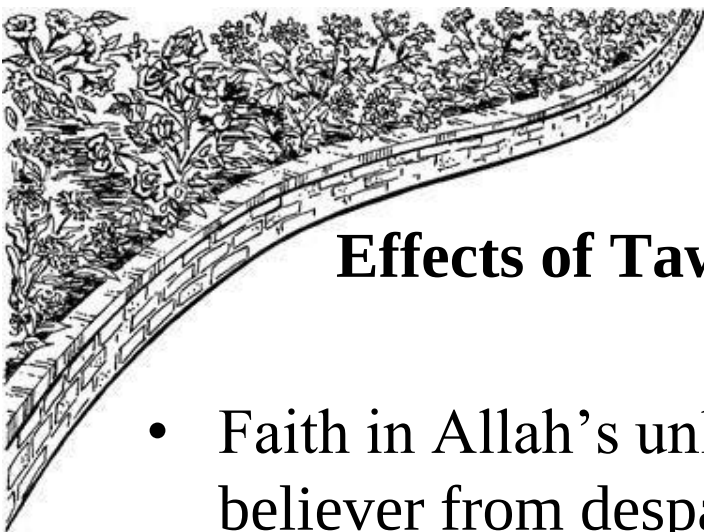




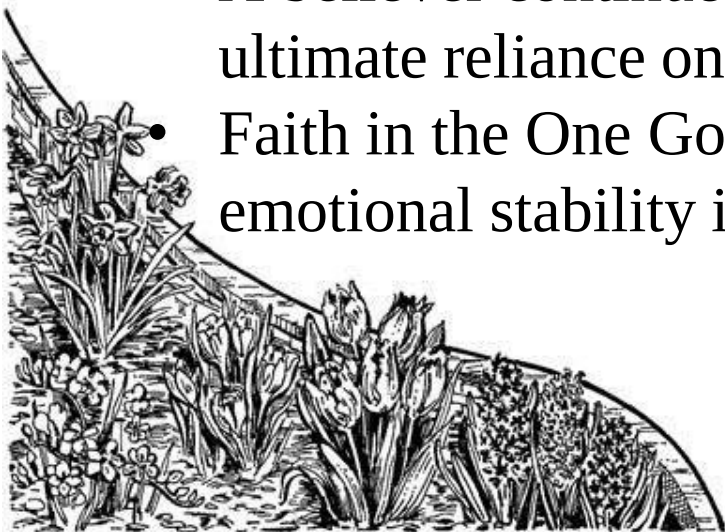
Effects of Tawheed on Character

Belief in Allah, the Creator and Sustainer of the entire universe, develops a sense of unity and compassion toward others.

- A believer knows that only Allah has ultimate power to benefit, harm, provide, and control life.
 - Tawheed prevents arrogance because a believer recognizes that all blessings and abilities come from Allah.
 - Belief in Allah encourages a person to live righteously, knowing that true success depends on good character and just actions.
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Effects of Tawheed on Strength and Resilience

- Faith in Allah's unlimited mercy and power protects a believer from despair during difficult times.
 - Dependence on Allah makes a person less fearful of worldly powers and difficulties.
 - Tawheed gives strength to remain firm when facing hardship, opposition, or setbacks.
 - A believer continues striving for what is right while placing ultimate reliance on Allah.
 - Faith in the One God provides confidence, purpose, and emotional stability in both ease and hardship.
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
