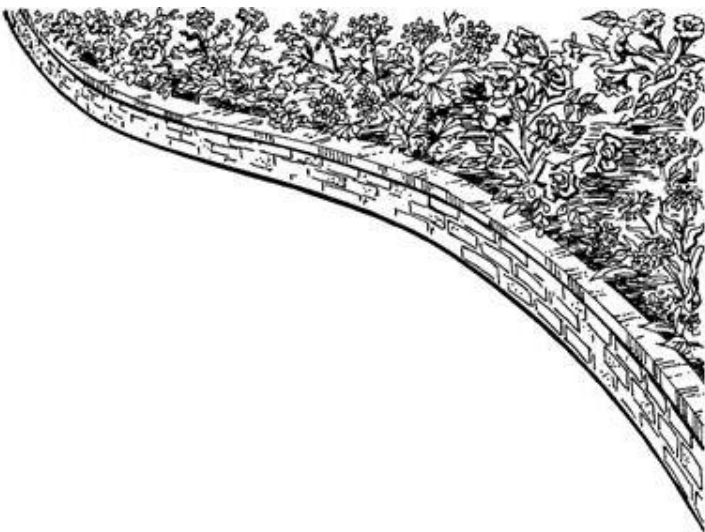

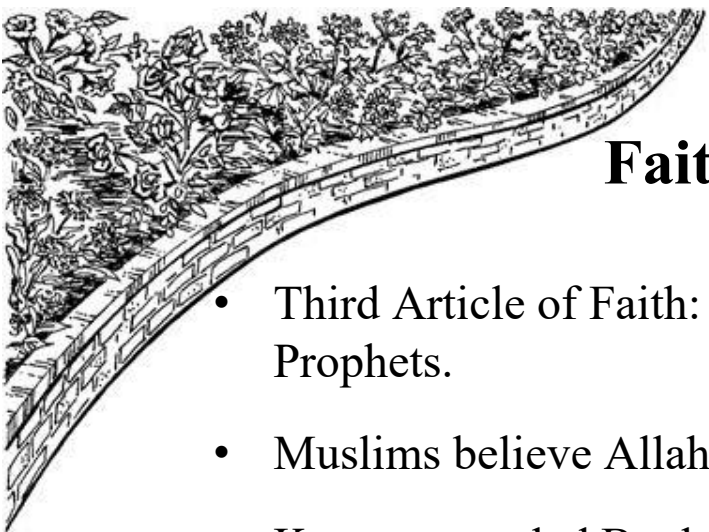

Faith in the Books of Allah

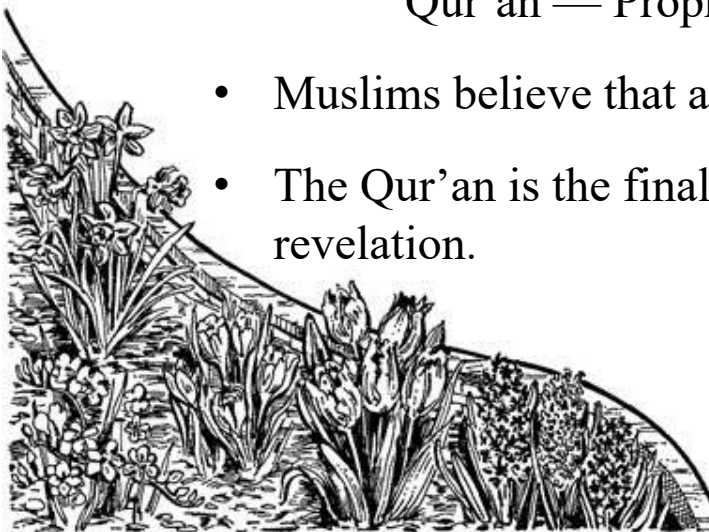
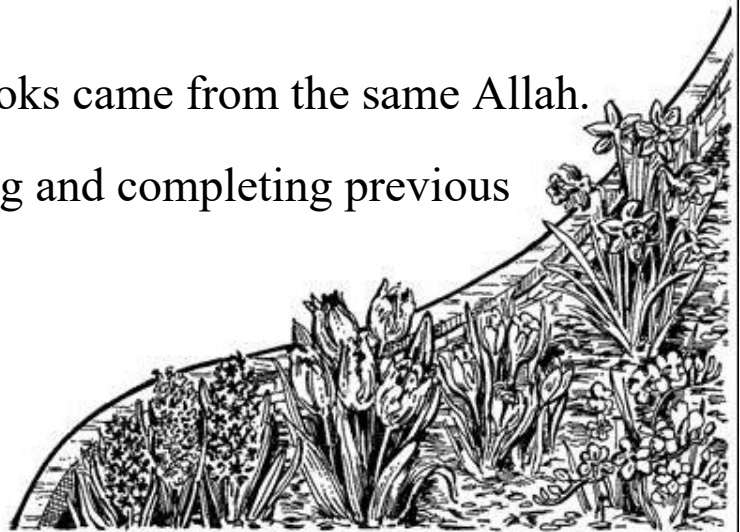
- Third Article of Faith: Belief in the Divine Books sent by Allah through His Prophets.
- Muslims believe Allah revealed guidance before the Qur'an.
- Known revealed Books include:

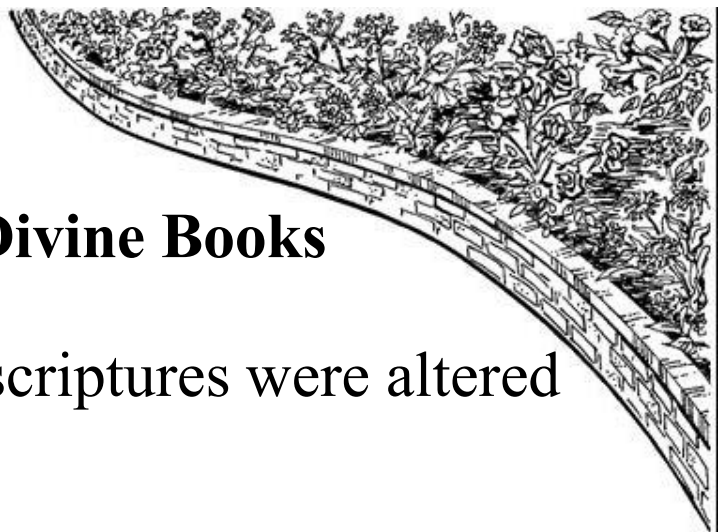
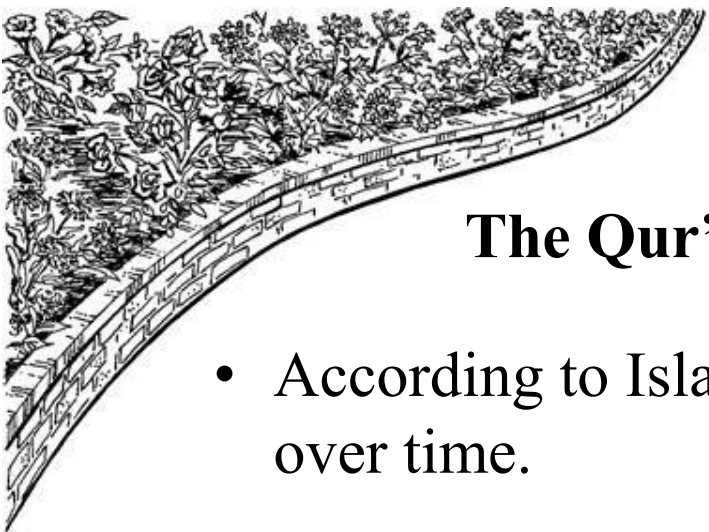
Torah — Prophet Musa (Moses)

Zabur — Prophet Dawud (David)

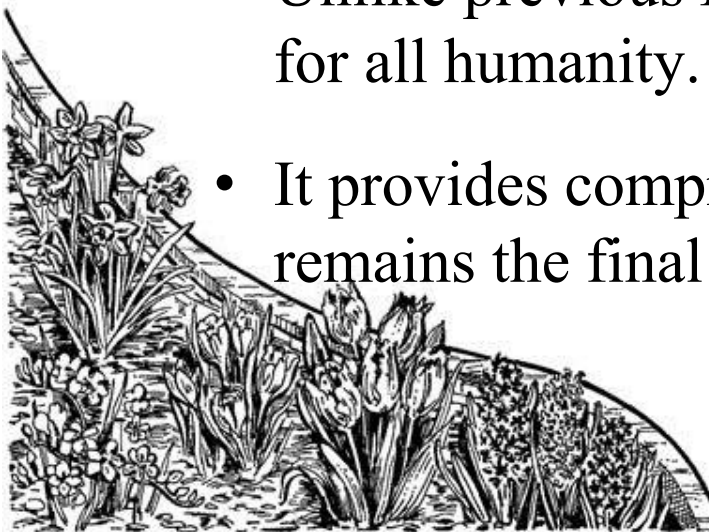
Injil — Prophet Isa (Jesus)

Qur'an — Prophet Muhammad (PBUH)

- Muslims believe that all originally revealed Books came from the same Allah.
 - The Qur'an is the final Divine Book, confirming and completing previous revelation.
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The Qur'an and Previous Divine Books

- According to Islamic belief, earlier scriptures were altered over time.
 - The Qur'an has been preserved in its original form.
 - It confirms the original truth of previous revelations and completes their guidance.
 - Unlike previous Books, the Qur'an is a universal message for all humanity.
 - It provides comprehensive guidance for human life and remains the final revelation from Allah.
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
