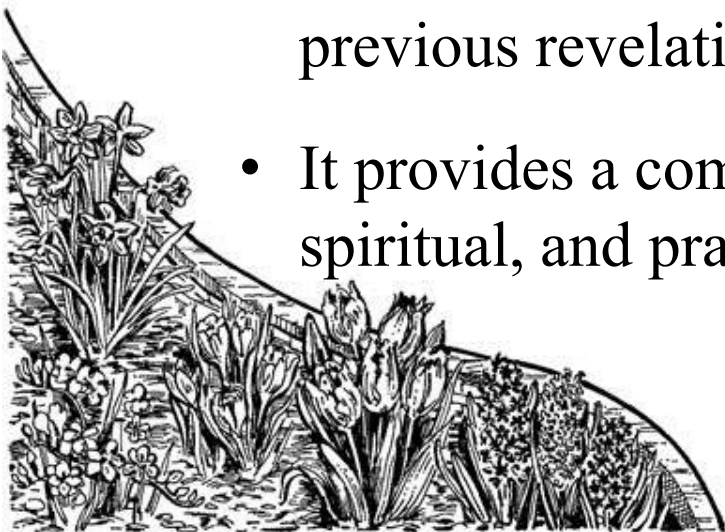


Preservation & Authenticity of the Qur'an
