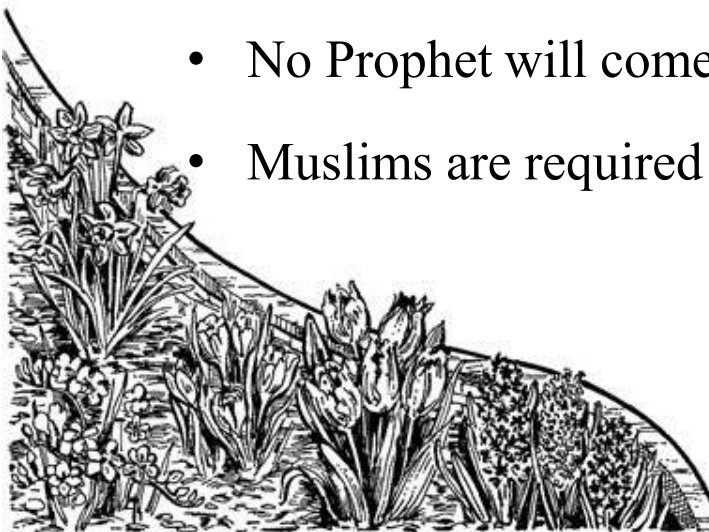
Comparing the similarities and differences between Prophet Muhammad (PBUH) and other Prophets

- Earlier Prophets were sent to specific peoples and periods.
 - Prophet Muhammad (PBUH) was sent for all humanity and all times.
 - His life, teachings, character, and practices have been preserved.
 - His message provides complete and universal guidance.
 - Muslims believe that following him means following the essential guidance of all Prophets.

To be a true Muslim, one must believe that:

- Muhammad (PBUH) is a true Prophet of Allah.
 - His teachings provide complete and perfect guidance.
 - He is the Last Prophet of Allah.
 - No Prophet will come after him until the Day of Judgment.
 - Muslims are required to believe in and follow his teachings.
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
