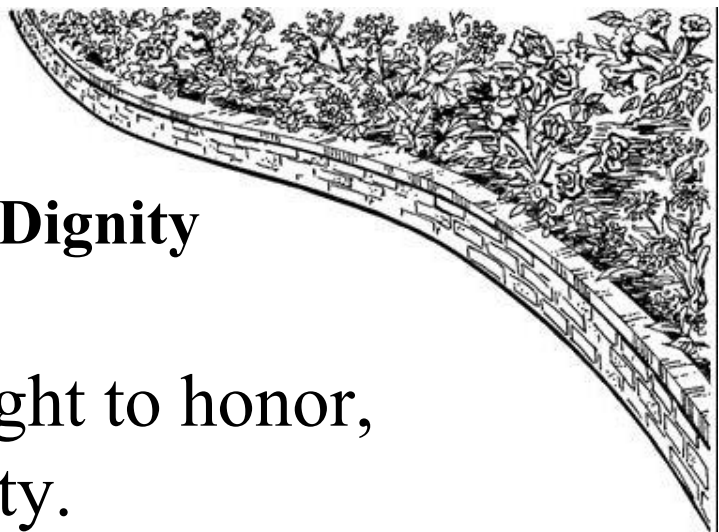
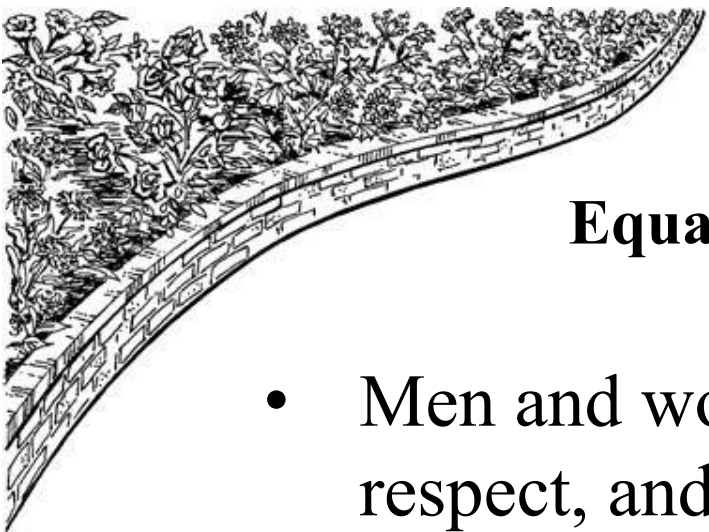


Equality in Rewards and Punishments

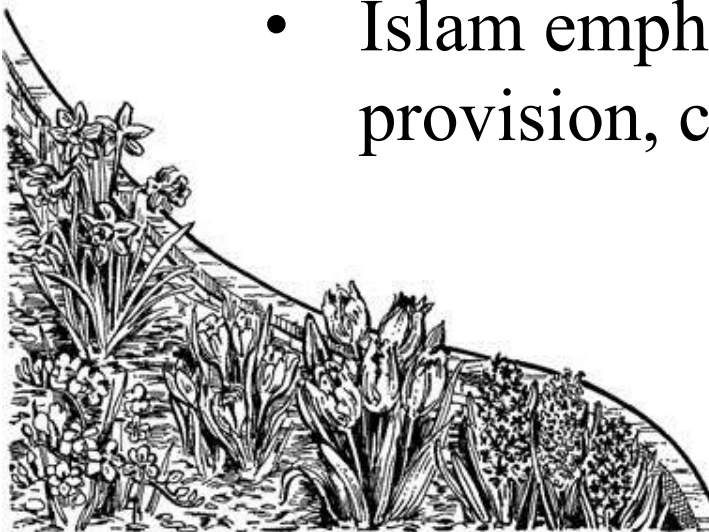
- Men and women are equally responsible for their actions.
- Righteous deeds are rewarded regardless of gender.
- Disobedience carries accountability for both men and women.



Qur'an 16:97: Allah (SWT) promises a **good life and reward** to believing men and women who do righteous deeds.



Equality in Honor and Dignity

- Men and women have the right to honor, respect, and personal integrity.
 - Both are expected to uphold chastity and good character.
 - False accusations against chaste women are strongly condemned (Qur'an 24:4).
 - Islam emphasizes that women are entitled to provision, clothing, and respectful treatment.
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
