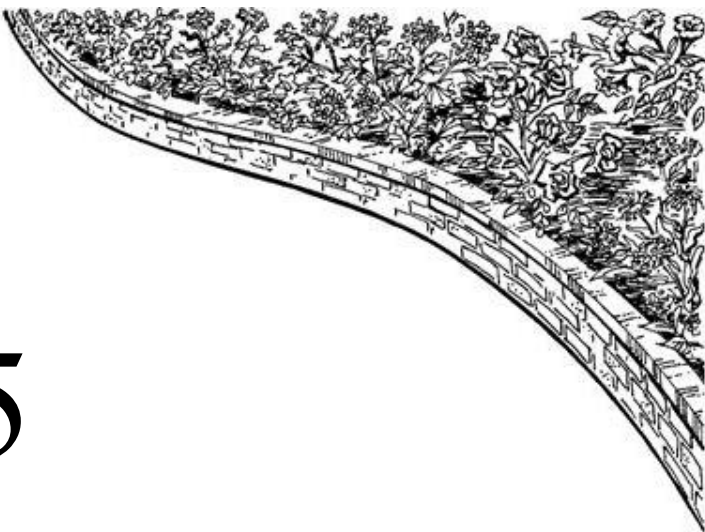

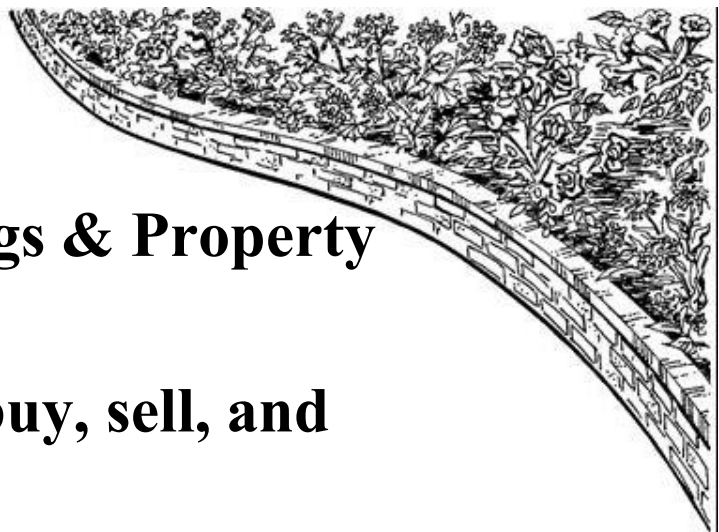
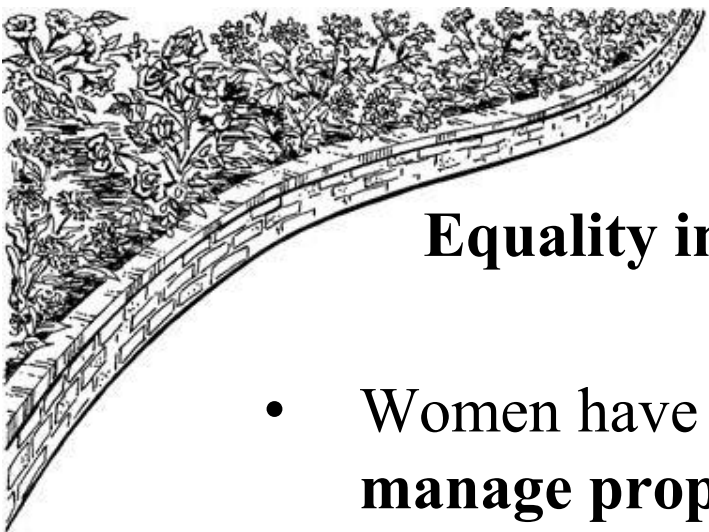
Rights of Women in Islam



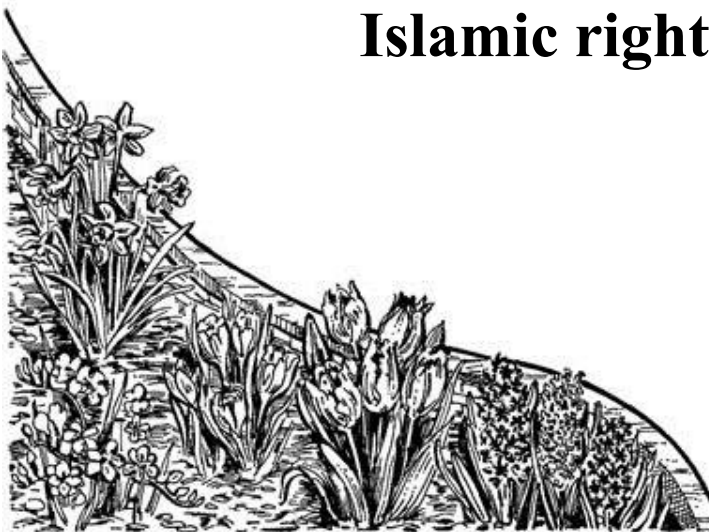
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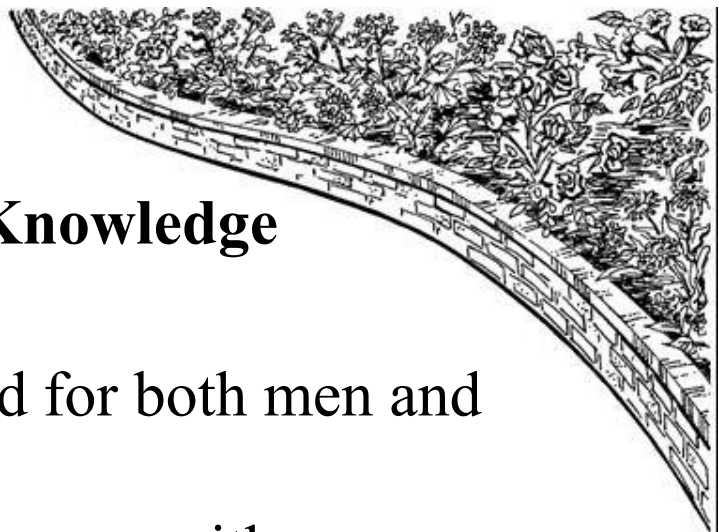
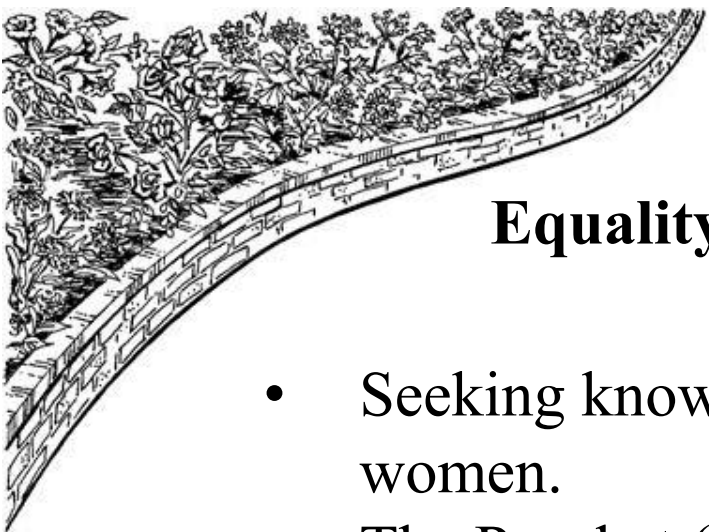
Identifying how Islam grants women equal rights in financial dealings, property ownership, and education, while emphasizing their complementary roles in family and society.



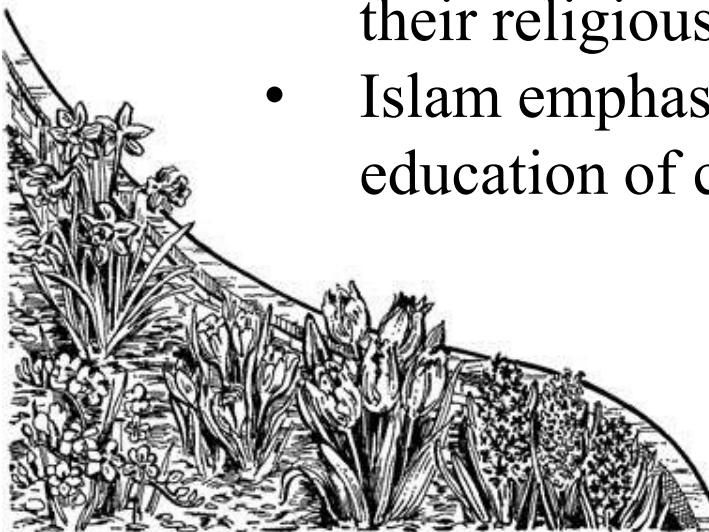


Equality in Financial Dealings & Property

- Women have the **right to own, buy, sell, and manage property**.
 - They can engage in **financial transactions** independently.
 - Islam grants women an **inheritance share** (Qur'an 4:7).
 - Their financial rights are recognized as **legitimate Islamic rights**.
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Equality in Education & Knowledge

- Seeking knowledge is encouraged for both men and women.
 - The Prophet (PBUH) provided women with opportunities for religious education.
 - Hazrat Aisha (RA) was a prominent scholar and transmitter of Islamic knowledge.
 - Education enables both men and women to fulfill their religious and family responsibilities.
 - Islam emphasizes the proper upbringing and education of children by both parents.
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
