Describe how Islam holds both Adam and Eve equally responsible for the First Sin and rejects blaming women alone.





Rejection of the "Original Sin" Concept

- Unlike some other traditions, Islam rejects the concept of woman as the cause of "Original Sin" or as a "product of the devil".
 - The Quran teaches that both Adam AS and Eve AS were equally responsible for eating from the forbidden tree, both repented, and both were equally forgiven by Allah.
 - Quranic references indicate that both were "equally in error," and some interpretations even suggest Adam AS bore a significant portion of the blame.
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
