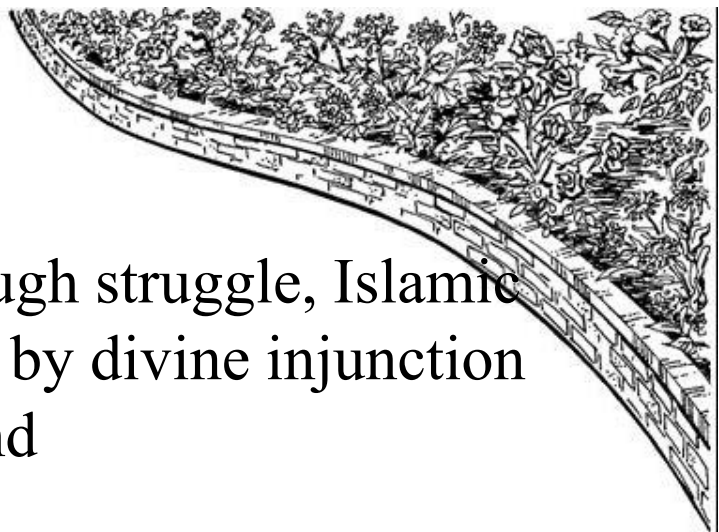
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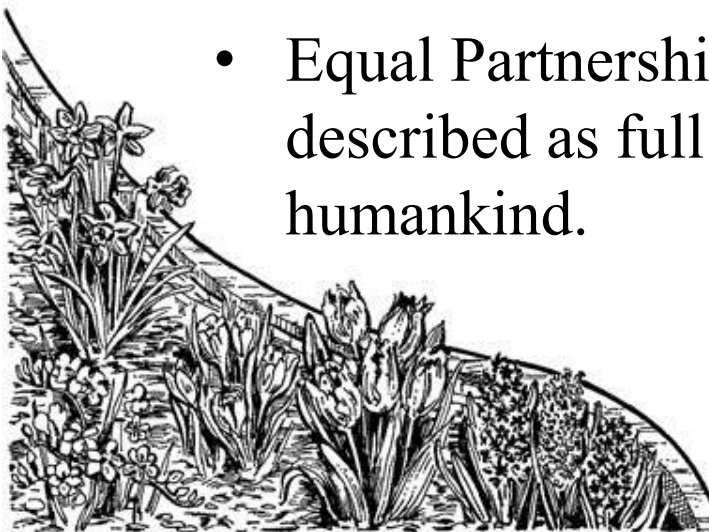
Compare the rights of women in Islam with those in the West according to her nature and explain common Western misconceptions about women's status in Islam.





Introduction



- Unlike modern rights obtained through struggle, Islamic rights were granted 1,400 years ago by divine injunction without the need for external demand
 - Alignment with Nature: Islamic laws align with a woman's fitrat (natural instinct), unlike some Western concepts of freedom that may conflict with a woman's primary responsibilities
 - Equal Partnership in Humanity: Men and women are described as full and equal partners in the reproduction of humankind.
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
