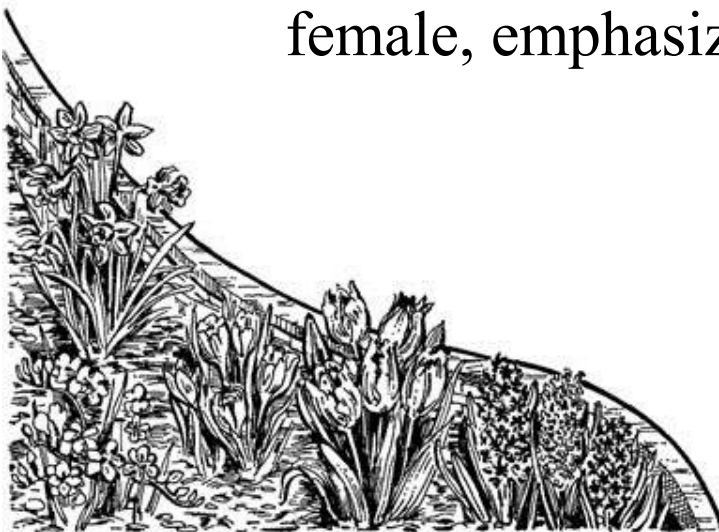
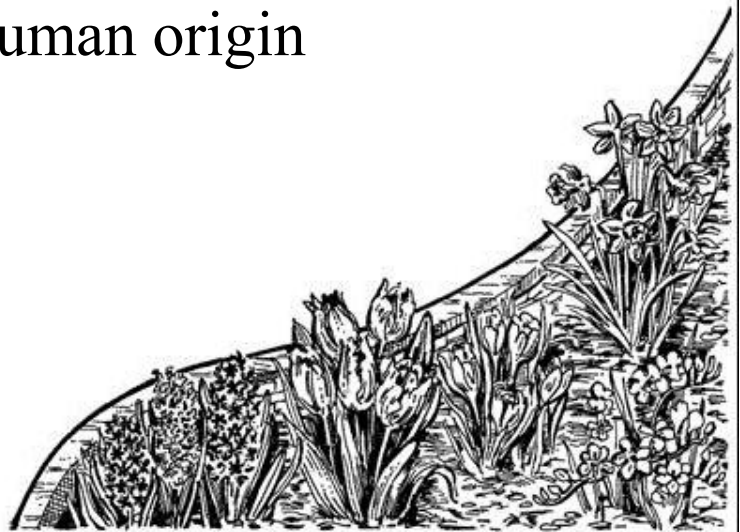
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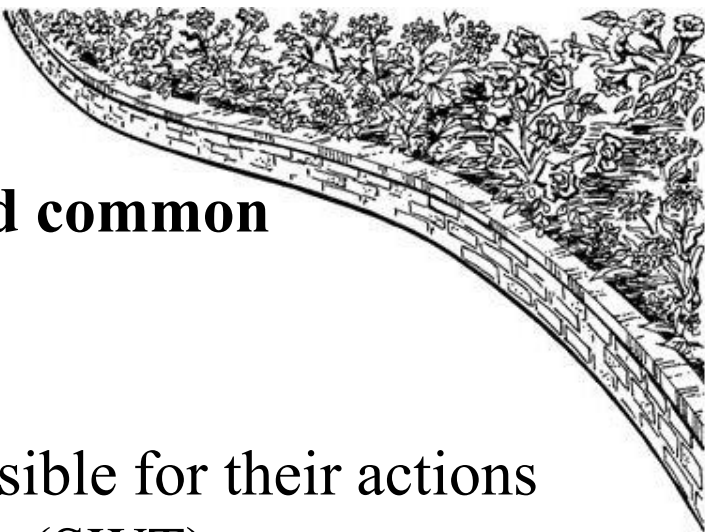
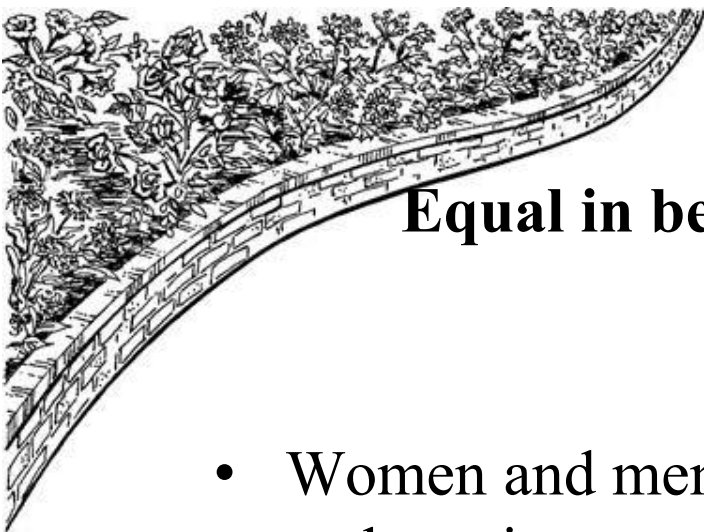
Outline women's equality with men in Islam in terms of partnership, responsibilities, and spiritual reward.



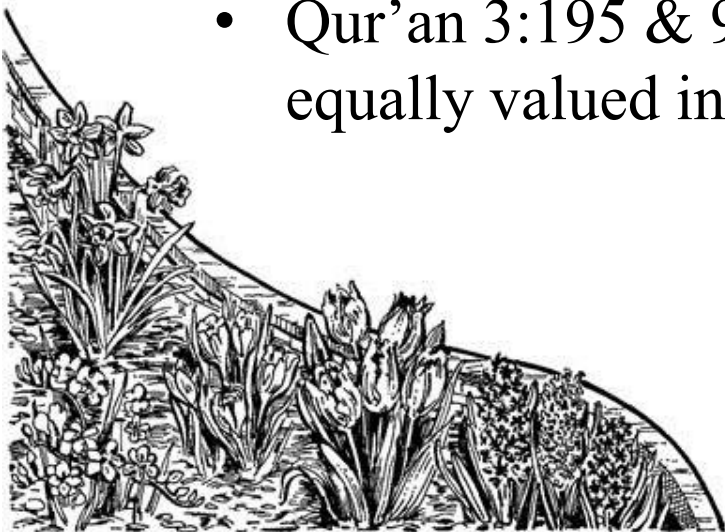


A full an and equal partner of man

- Islam recognizes women as full and equal partners of men in the continuation of humankind.
 - Both men and women are essential and equally valuable, with equal dignity, rights, and responsibilities.
 - Their humanity and qualities are equally honored by Allah (SWT).
 - Qur'an 49:13: Humanity was created from a male and a female, emphasizing their shared human origin
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Equal in bearing personal and common responsibilities

- Women and men are equally responsible for their actions and receive equal reward from Allah (SWT).
 - A woman is recognized as an independent individual with her own spiritual and moral responsibilities.
 - Both men and women are encouraged to do good, avoid evil, pray, give Zakah, and obey Allah.
 - Qur'an 3:195 & 9:71 affirm that both men and women are equally valued in faith and righteous deeds.
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
