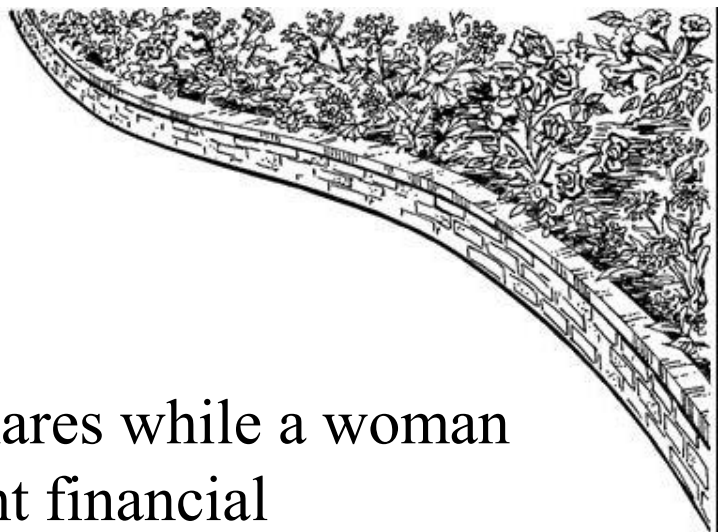
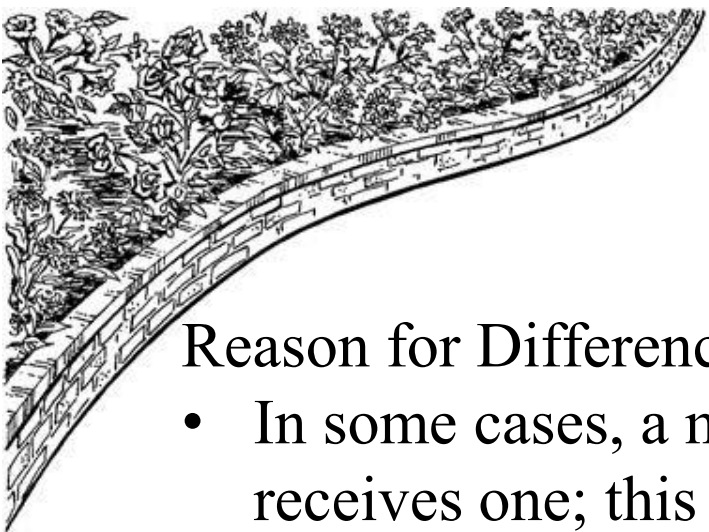




Some critical issues about Women Rights

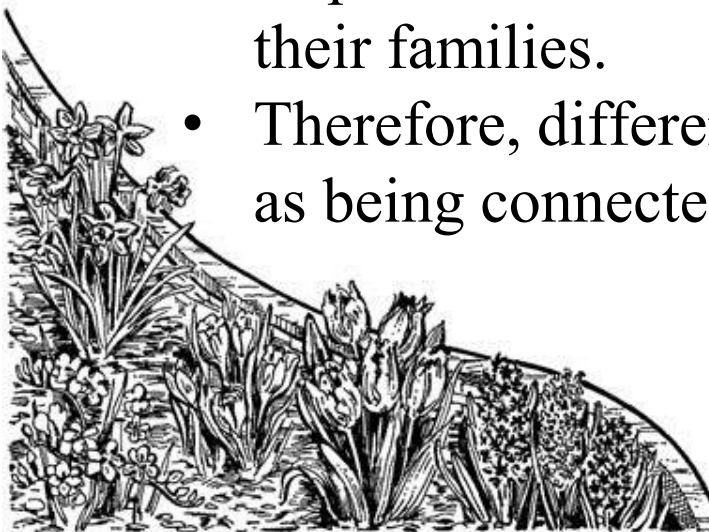
Inheritance

- Islam recognizes women as independent individuals and gives them a legal share of inheritance.
 - A woman may inherit as a wife, mother, daughter, or sister, depending on her relationship to the deceased.
 - Her inherited share belongs to her, and no one has the right to take it away or disinherit her.
 - Inheritance is determined according to the degree of relationship and the number of heirs.

Reason for Differences in Shares

- In some cases, a man receives two shares while a woman receives one; this is linked to different financial responsibilities, not superiority.
 - Men are responsible for financially supporting their wives, children, and other dependents.
 - Women are generally not required to bear these financial responsibilities and are entitled to financial support from their families.
 - Therefore, differences in inheritance shares are presented as being connected to financial duties and responsibilities.
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
