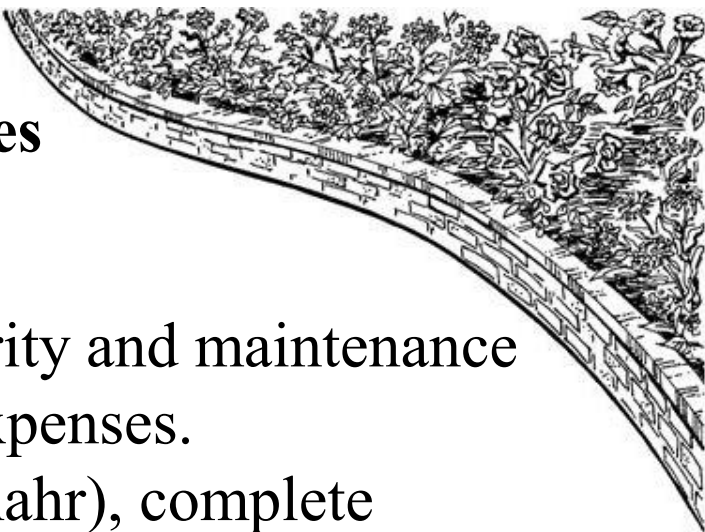


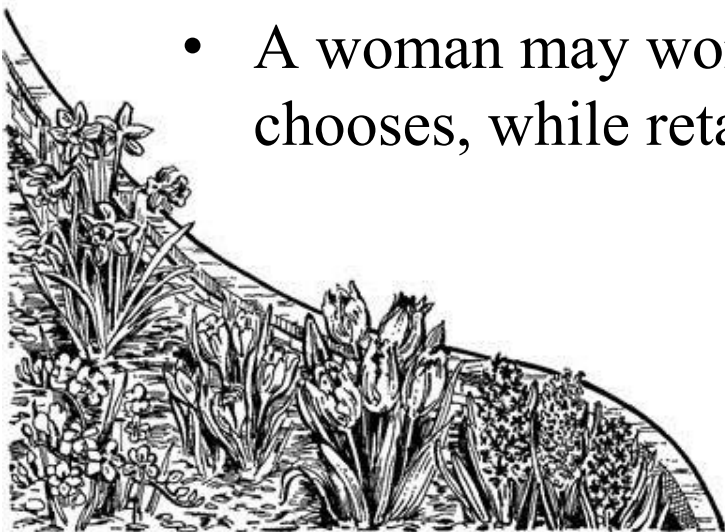
## Witness

- In certain civil contracts, Islamic law requires two men or one man and two women as witnesses.
  - This is presented as a measure to protect the rights of all parties involved in the contract.
  - The second female witness can remind or support the first if she forgets or makes an error.
  - The distinction is described in terms of practical experience and safeguarding the contract, not human worth.
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## Financial Liabilities



- Women are entitled to financial security and maintenance and are not required to bear family expenses.
  - As a wife, she is entitled to dowry (mahr), complete maintenance, and ownership of her personal property.
  - As a daughter or sister, she is entitled to care and financial support from her father or brother.
  - As a mother, she receives special honor and recognition in Islam.
  - A woman may work and contribute financially if she chooses, while retaining her own property.
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
