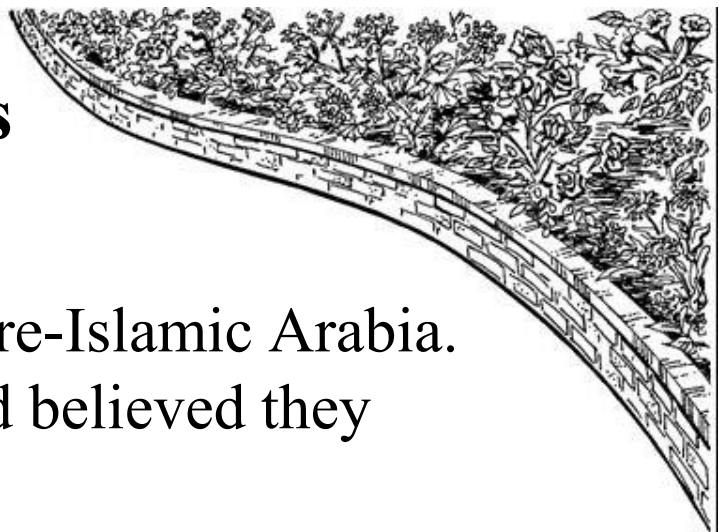


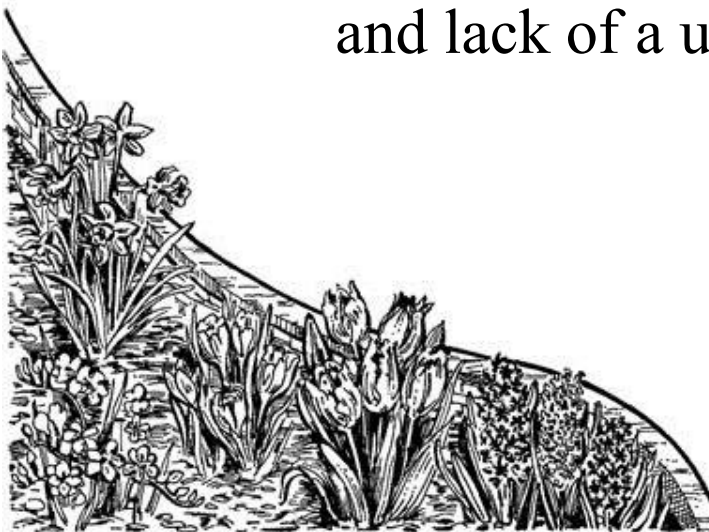
History of Arabs

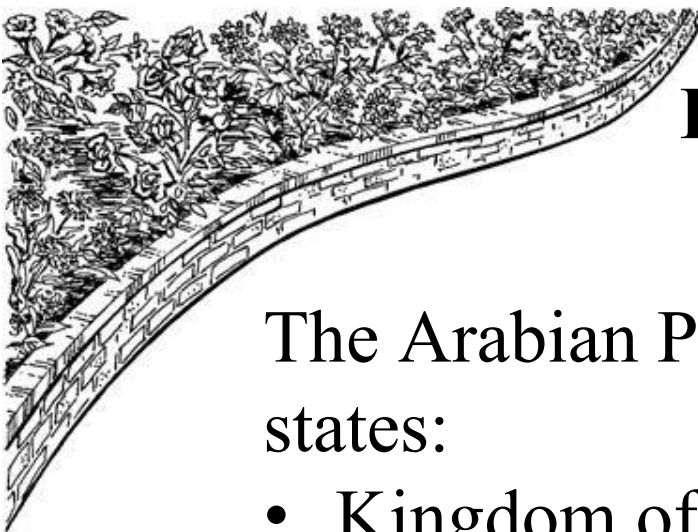
- Pre-Islamic Arabs were known for their:

 - They had a strong intellectual nature and valued poetry as an important form of expression.
 - Poetry reflected their culture, values, traditions, and daily life.
 - Despite their hospitality, robbing travelers was also common.
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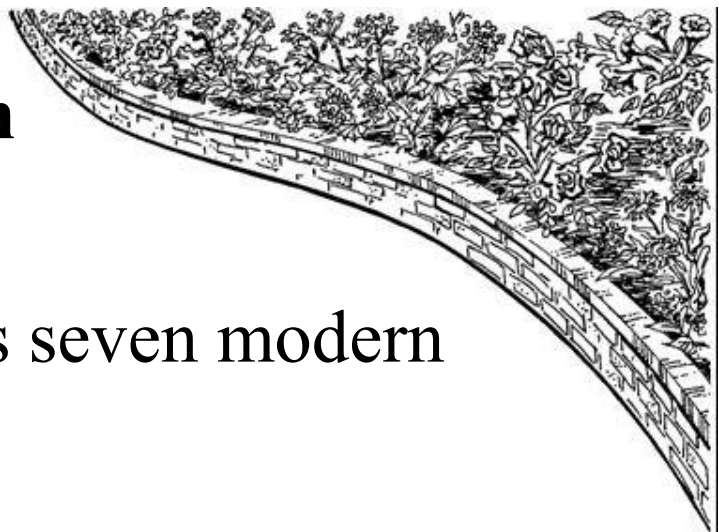
History of Arabs



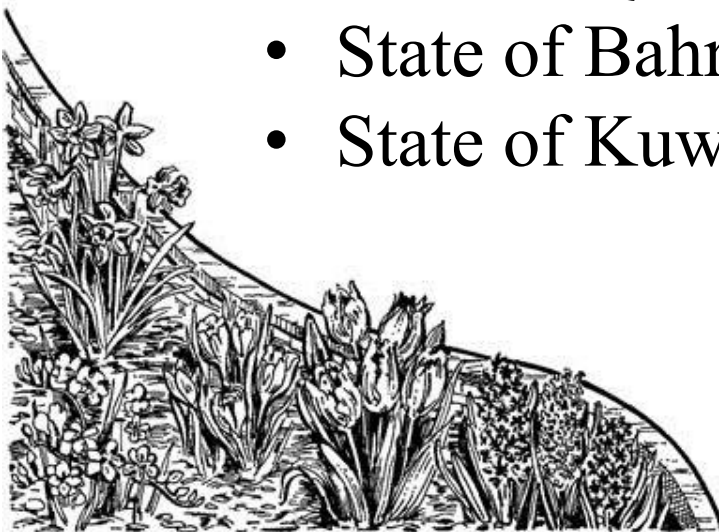
- Idol worship was widespread in pre-Islamic Arabia.
 - Many Arabs worshipped idols and believed they could intercede with God.
 - The Kaaba in Makkah contained numerous idols before Islam.
 - Different tribes often had their own idols and religious practices.
 - Society faced lawlessness, tribal conflicts, revenge, and lack of a unified legal system.
