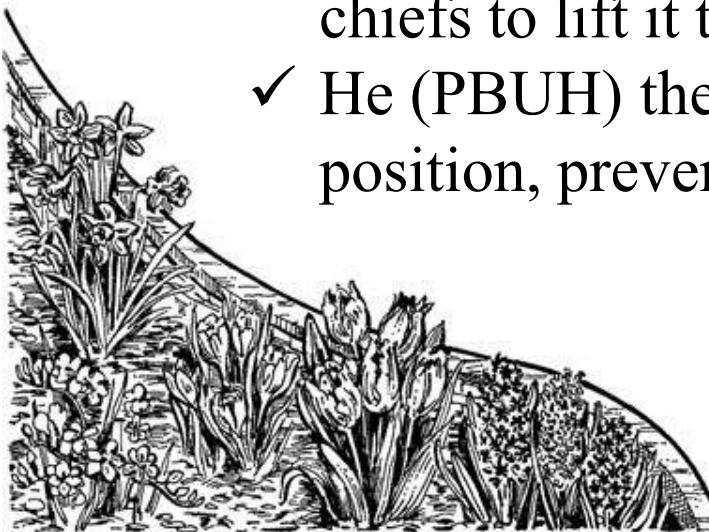


Youth of Prophet Muhammad (PBUH)

- ✓ Learned business from his uncle Abu Talib and began trading at a young age.
 - ✓ Was known for honesty, kindness, simplicity, and keeping promises.
 - ✓ Believed in one Allah and was respected by the people of Makkah.
 - ✓ Supported Hilf-ul-Fudhul, promoting peace, justice, and protection of the weak.
 - ✓ Known as As-Sadiq (The Truthful) and Al-Ameen (The Trustworthy).
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Rebuilding of the Ka'bah

- ✓ The Ka'bah was damaged by floods and was rebuilt by the tribes of Makkah.
 - ✓ The tribes disagreed over who would place the Hajr-e-Aswad (Black Stone).
 - ✓ Prophet Muhammad (PBUH) proposed a fair solution to end the dispute.
 - ✓ He placed the stone on a sheet and asked the tribal chiefs to lift it together.
 - ✓ He (PBUH) then placed the Black Stone in its proper position, preventing conflict.
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
