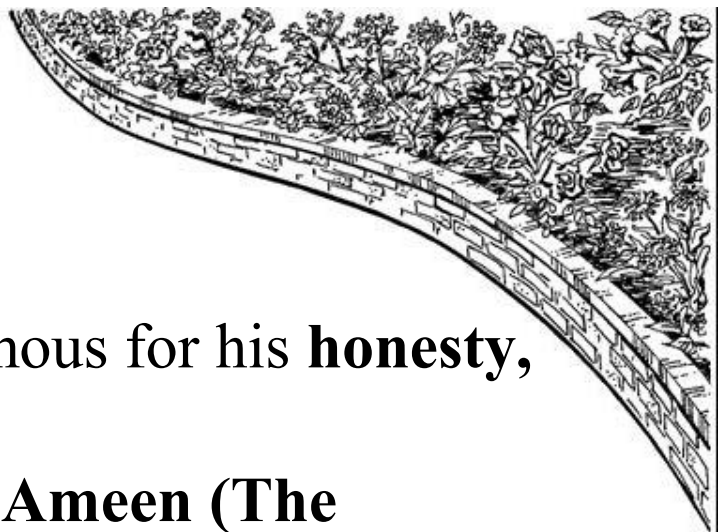
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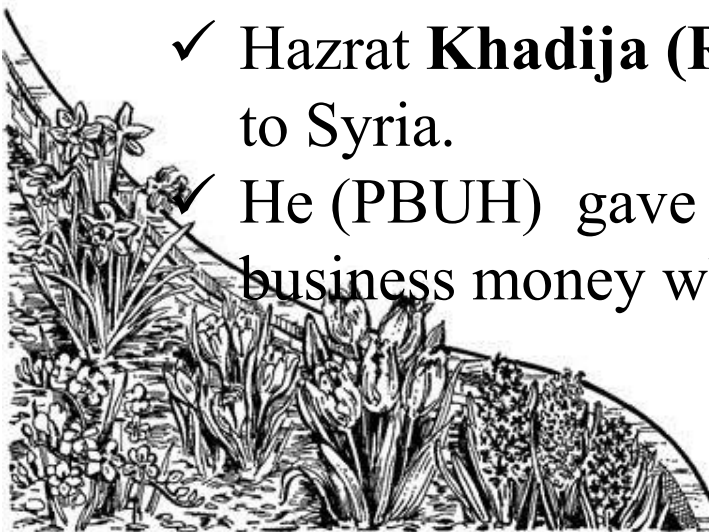
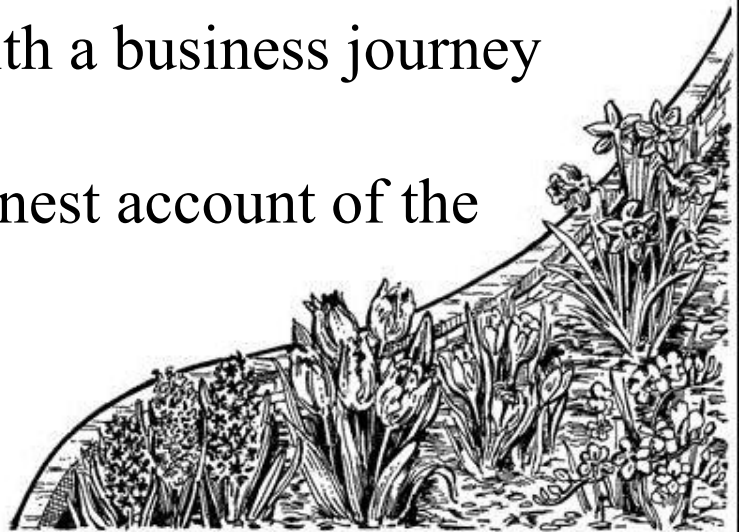
Explore the Prophet Muhammad's (PBUH) manhood, highlighting his character, responsibilities, and his blessed marriage to Khadijah (RA).

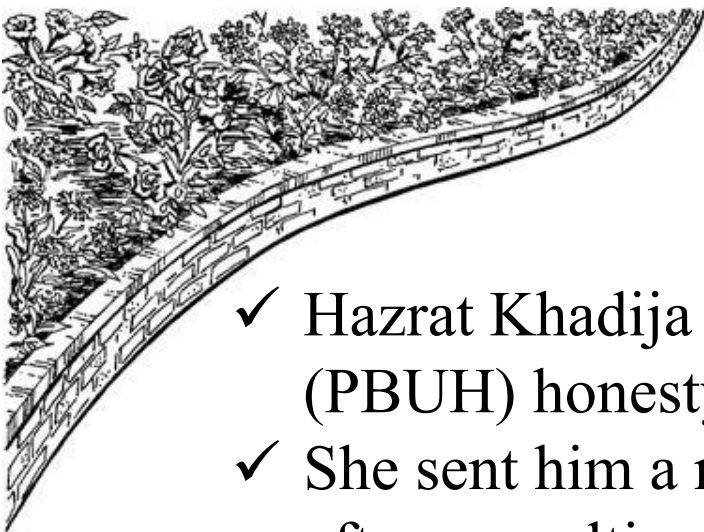




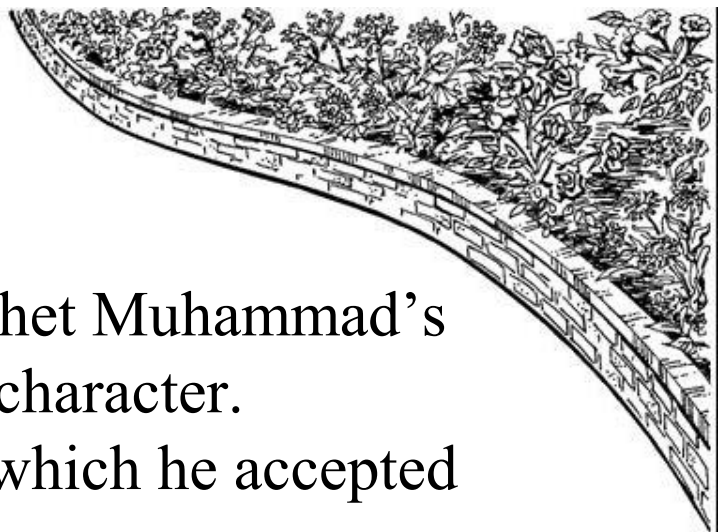
Manhood

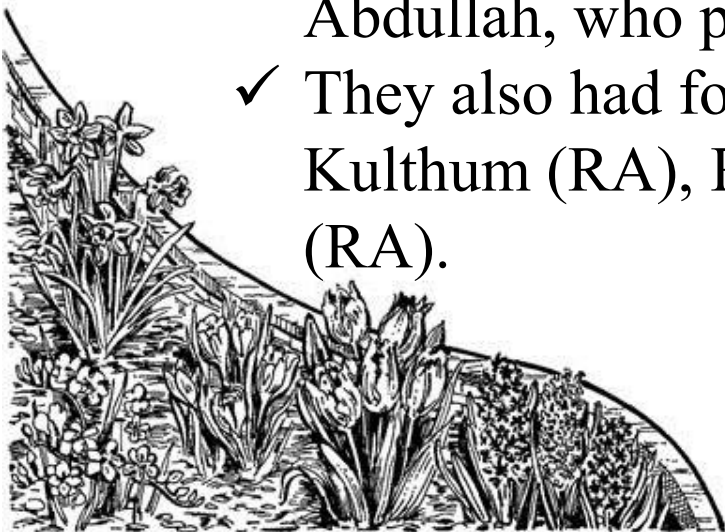


- ✓ Prophet Muhammad (PBUH) was famous for his **honesty, truthfulness, and good manners.**
 - ✓ The people of Makkah called him **Al-Ameen (The Trustworthy).**
 - ✓ People trusted him with their valuable goods for safekeeping.
 - ✓ He (PBUH) disliked the wrong practices around him and often went to the **Cave of Hira** to remember Allah.
 - ✓ Hazrat **Khadija (RA)** trusted him with a business journey to Syria.
 - ✓ He (PBUH) gave a complete and honest account of the business money when he returned.
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Marriage



- ✓ Hazrat Khadija (RA) admired Prophet Muhammad's (PBUH) honesty, virtue, and good character.
 - ✓ She sent him a marriage proposal, which he accepted after consulting his uncle Abu Talib.
 - ✓ At the time of marriage, Hazrat Khadija (RA) was 40 and Prophet Muhammad (PBUH) was 25.
 - ✓ Abu Talib performed the Nikah.
 - ✓ Their marriage was blessed with two sons: Qasim and Abdullah, who passed away in childhood.
 - ✓ They also had four daughters: Zaynab (RA), Umm Kulthum (RA), Ruqayyah (RA), and Hazrat Fatimah (RA).
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
