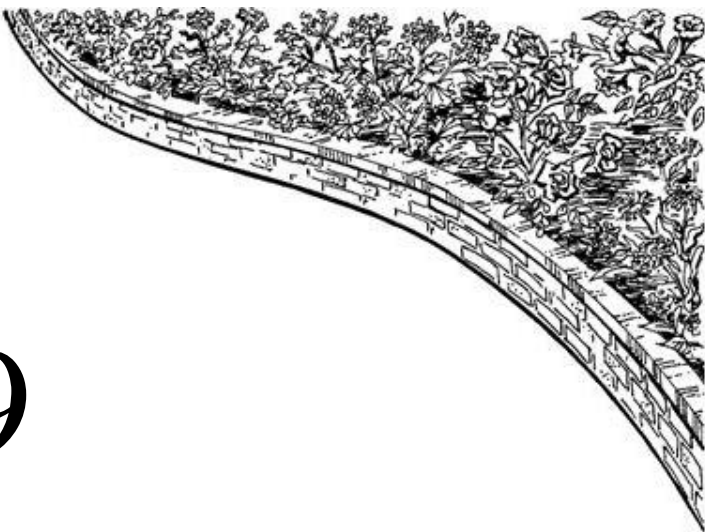

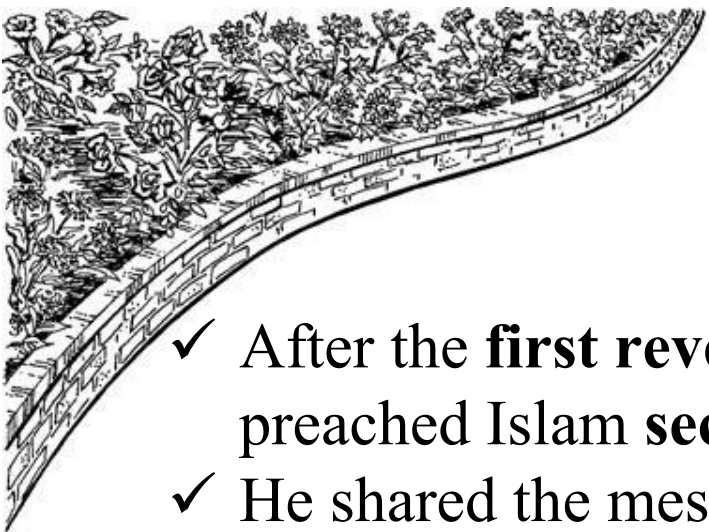
**Early Life and Prophethood of Prophet Muhammad

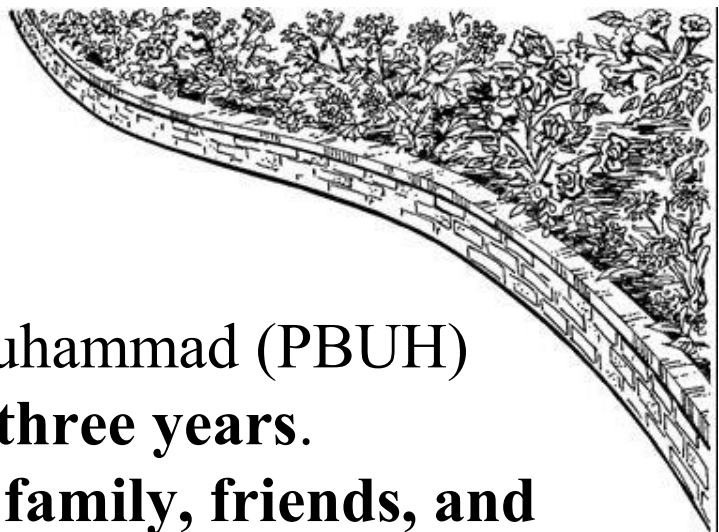

Preaching



- ✓ After the **first revelation**, Prophet Muhammad (PBUH) preached Islam **secretly for the first three years**.
- ✓ He shared the message with his **close family, friends, and trusted companions**.
- ✓ Many respected companions accepted Islam during this period.
- ✓ Among them were:

Hazrat Usman bin Affan (RA)

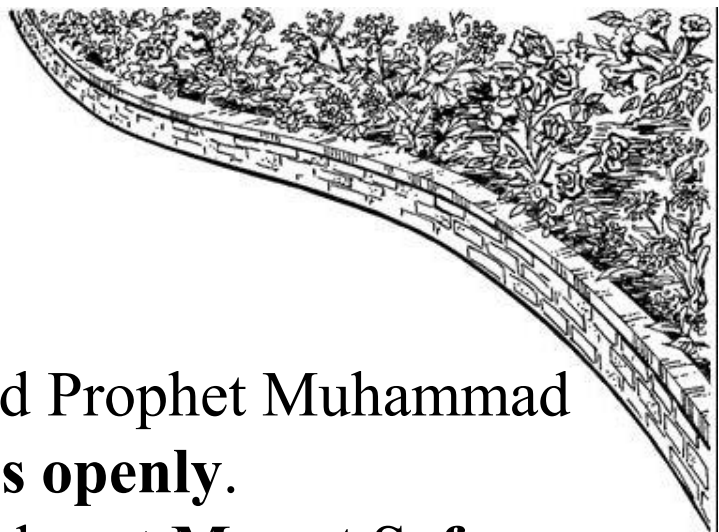
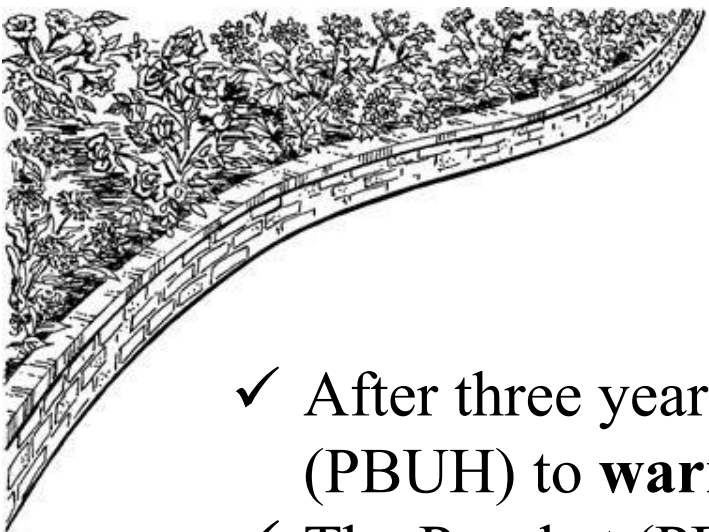
Hazrat Talha (RA)

Hazrat Zubair bin Al-Awwam (RA)

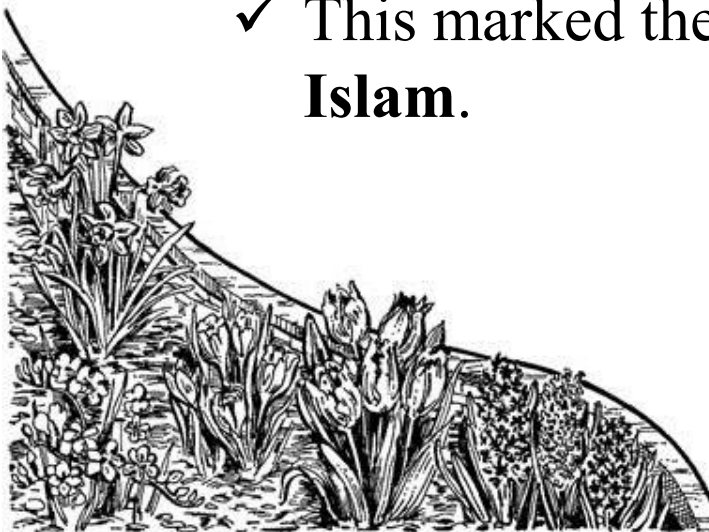
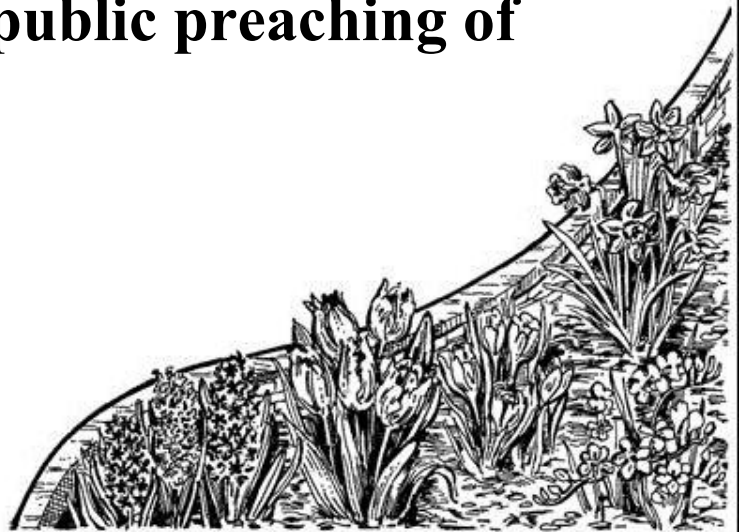
Hazrat Saad bin Abi Waqas (RA)

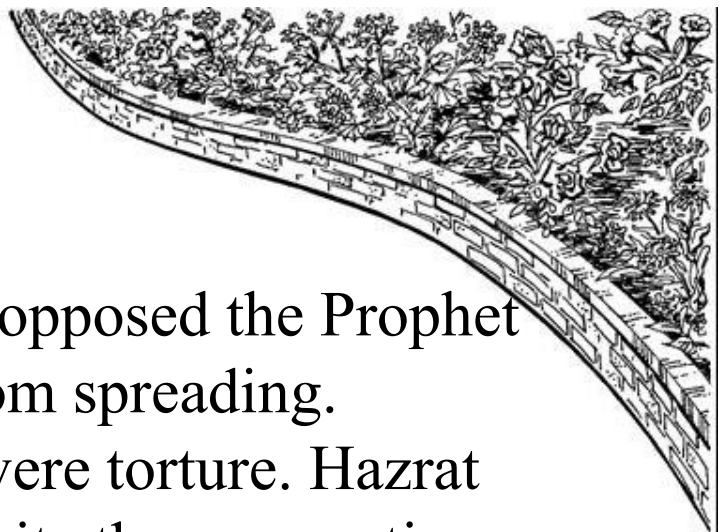
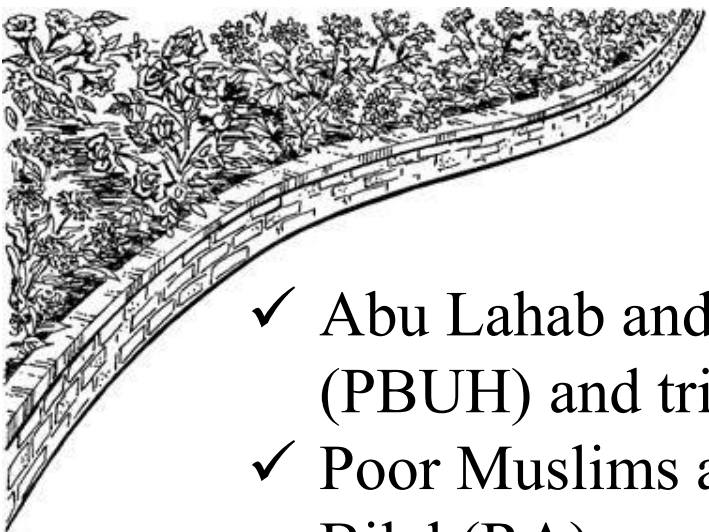

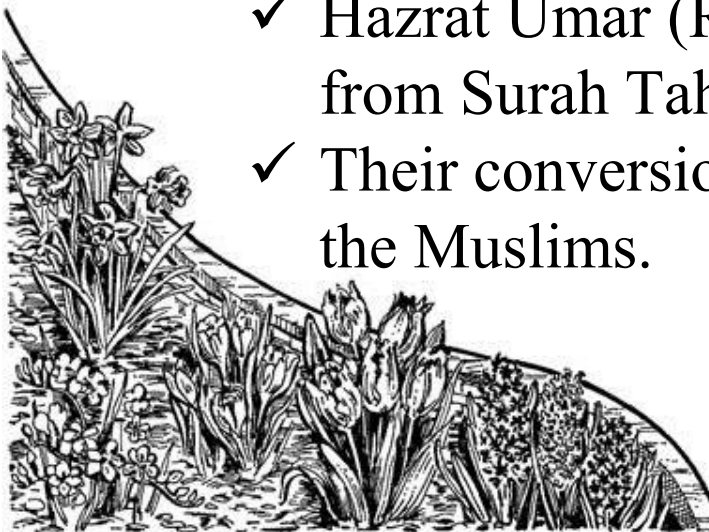


Preaching

- ✓ After three years, Allah commanded Prophet Muhammad (PBUH) to **warn his close relatives openly**.
 - ✓ The Prophet (PBUH) gathered his clan at **Mount Safa**.
 - ✓ He openly declared his **Prophethood**.
 - ✓ He called the people to **worship Allah alone**.
 - ✓ He urged them to **give up idol worship** and follow the message of Islam.
 - ✓ This marked the beginning of the **public preaching of Islam**.
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Preaching

- ✓ Abu Lahab and Abu Jahl strongly opposed the Prophet (PBUH) and tried to stop Islam from spreading.
 - ✓ Poor Muslims and slaves faced severe torture. Hazrat Bilal (RA) remained steadfast despite the persecution.
 - ✓ The Prophet (PBUH) prayed for Allah to strengthen Islam through Abu Jahl or Hazrat Umar (RA).
 - ✓ Hazrat Hamzah (RA) accepted Islam after seeing the Prophet (PBUH) being mistreated.
 - ✓ Hazrat Umar (RA) accepted Islam after hearing verses from Surah Taha.
 - ✓ Their conversions greatly strengthened and encouraged the Muslims.
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
