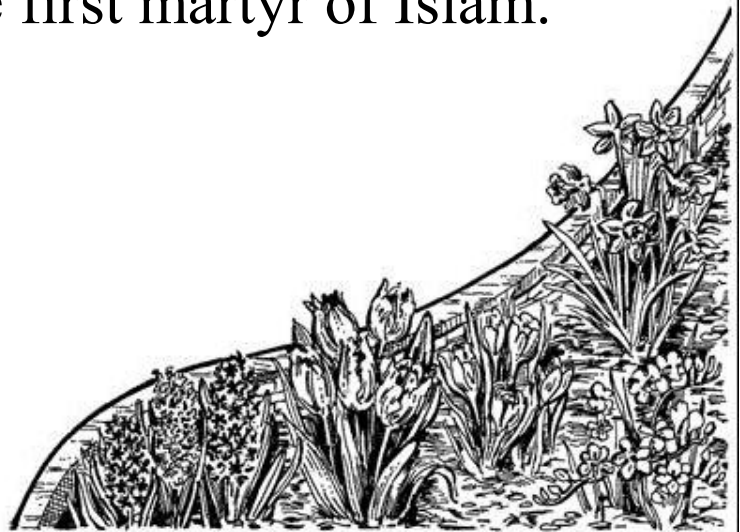
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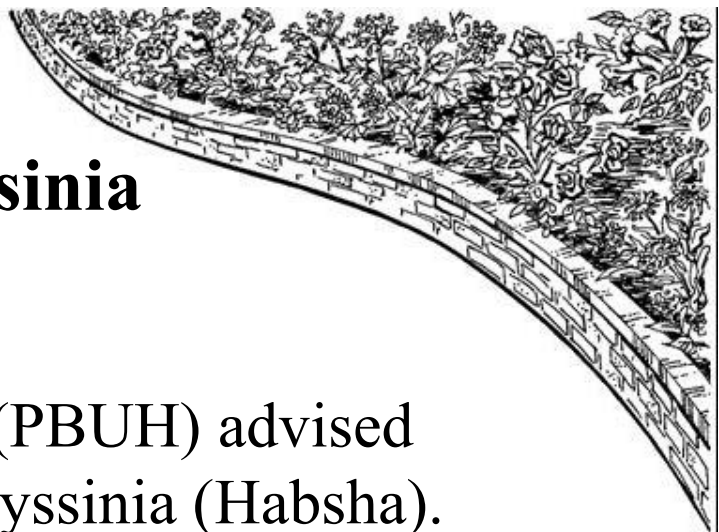
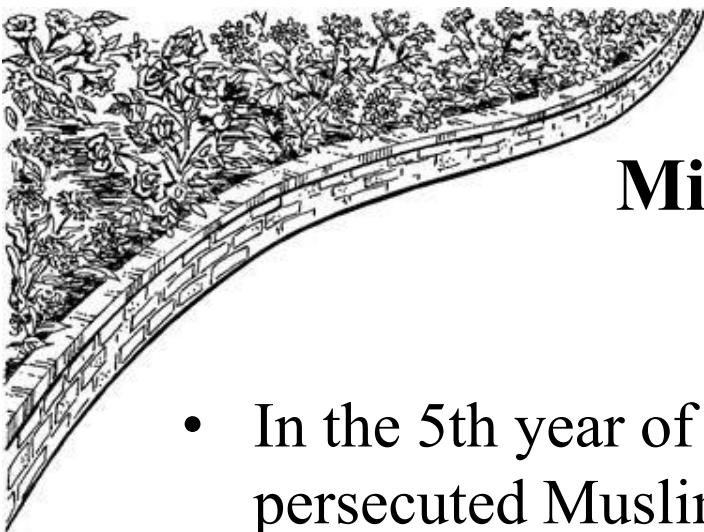
Understand how early Muslims faced severe persecution and how their migration to Abyssinia, along with key conversions, strengthened their ability to practice Islam openly.



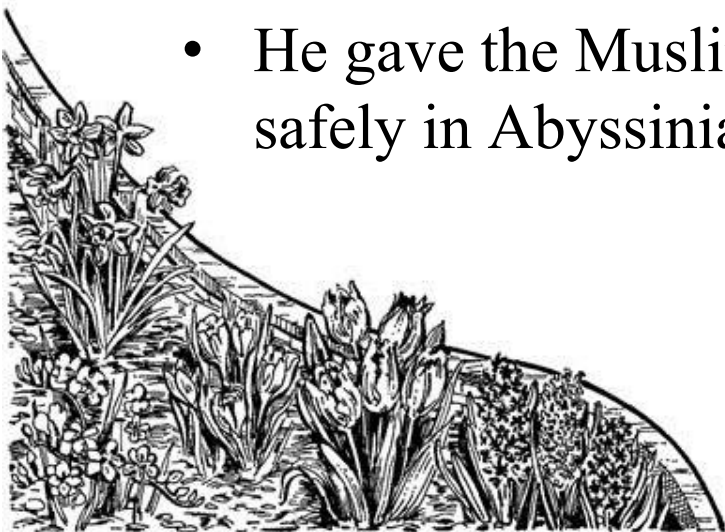


Torture and persecution

- ✓ Quraysh offered the Prophet (PBUH) wealth, leadership, and marriage to stop his preaching.
 - ✓ He (PBUH) firmly rejected all offers and refused to abandon the message of Islam.
 - ✓ The Quraysh then began severe persecution of Muslims.
 - ✓ Hazrat Bilal (RA), Hazrat Sumayyah (RA), Hazrat Yasir (RA), and others suffered brutal torture.
 - ✓ Hazrat Sumayyah (RA) became the first martyr of Islam.
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Migration to Abyssinia

- In the 5th year of Islam, the Prophet (PBUH) advised persecuted Muslims to migrate to Abyssinia (Habsha).
 - King Najashi was known for his justice and kindness.
 - Hazrat Ja'far (RA) explained Islam and recited verses from Surah Maryam about Isa (AS).
 - Najashi was deeply moved and refused the Quraysh's demands.
 - He gave the Muslims protection and allowed them to stay safely in Abyssinia.
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
