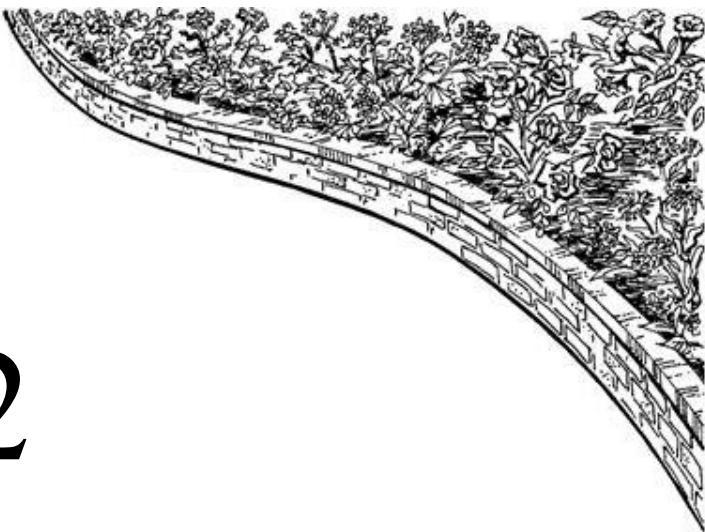

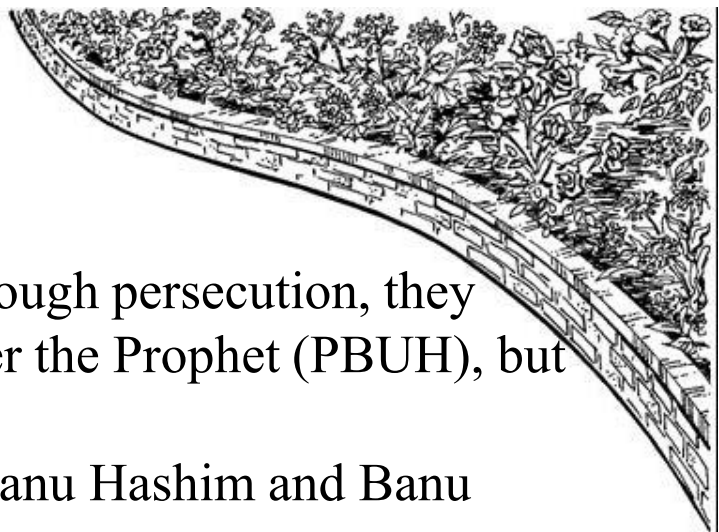
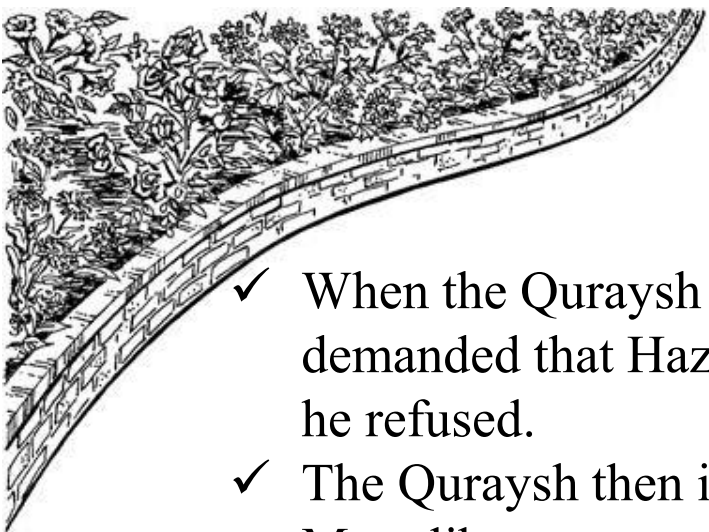
**Life of Prophet Muhammad (PBUH) Makki and
Madani Period**



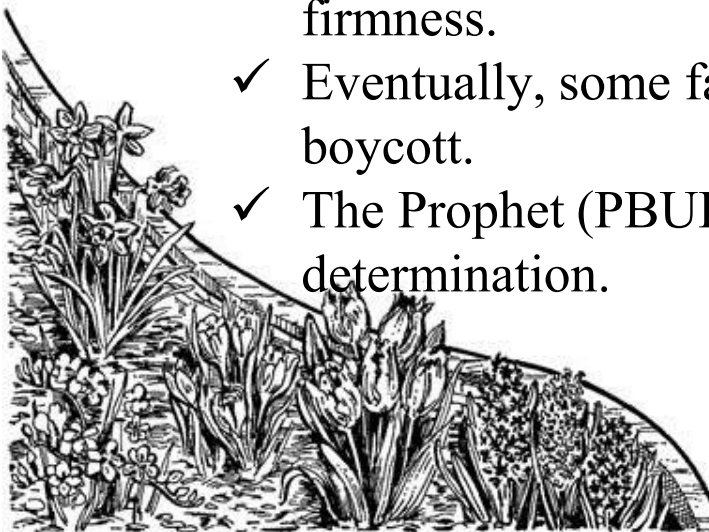
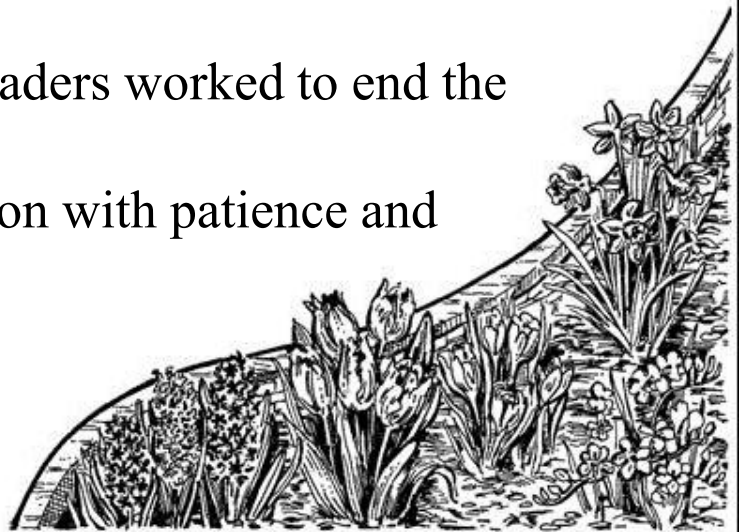
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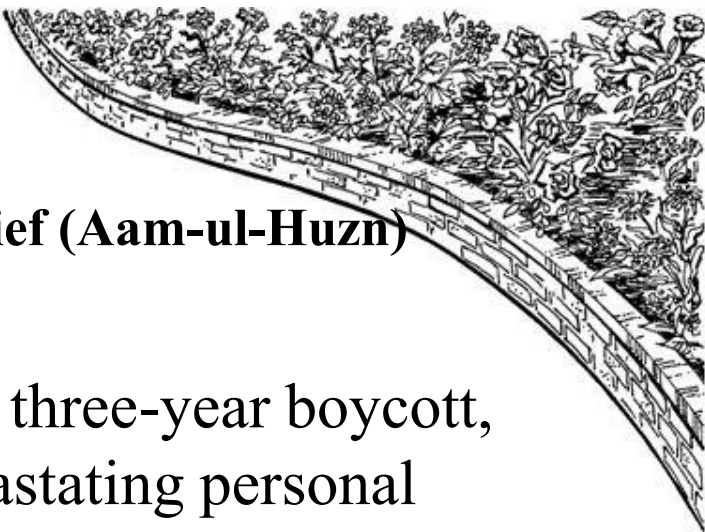
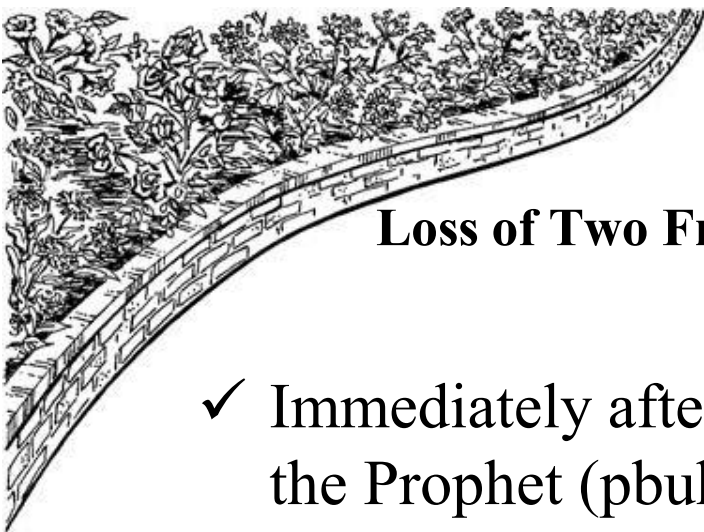
Discuss the boycott of Banu Hashim that how Prophet Muhammad (PBUH) and his family showed patience and unity, continuing their mission despite persecution.



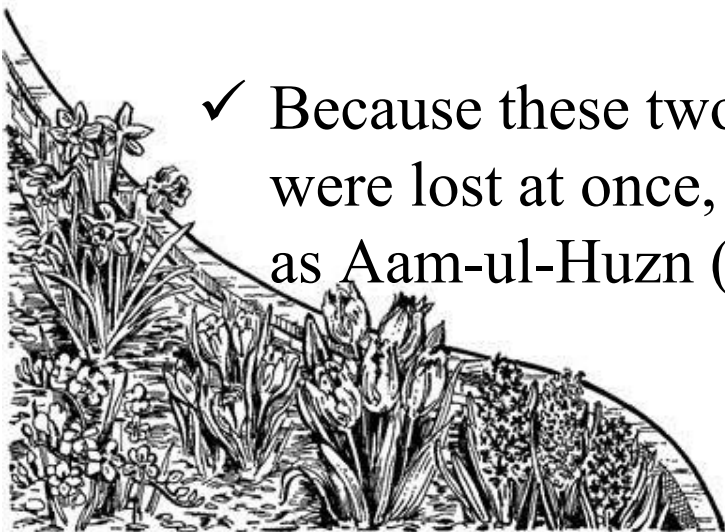


Boycott

- ✓ When the Quraysh failed to stop Islam through persecution, they demanded that Hazrat Abu Talib hand over the Prophet (PBUH), but he refused.
 - ✓ The Quraysh then imposed a boycott on Banu Hashim and Banu Muttalib.
 - ✓ They were forced to live in Shu'ab Abi Talib for about three years, facing severe hunger and hardship.
 - ✓ They could not buy, sell, or communicate normally with the people of Makkah.
 - ✓ Despite the difficulties, they showed great patience, unity, and firmness.
 - ✓ Eventually, some fair-minded Quraysh leaders worked to end the boycott.
 - ✓ The Prophet (PBUH) continued his mission with patience and determination.
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Loss of Two Friends The Year of Grief (Aam-ul-Huzn)

- ✓ Immediately after the relief from the three-year boycott, the Prophet (pbuh) suffered two devastating personal losses.
 - ✓ His beloved wife, Hazrat Khadija (RA), and his protective uncle, Hazrat Abu Talib, both passed away in the same year.
 - ✓ Because these two pillars of emotional and societal support were lost at once, the Prophet (pbuh) designated this year as Aam-ul-Huzn (the Year of Grief).
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
