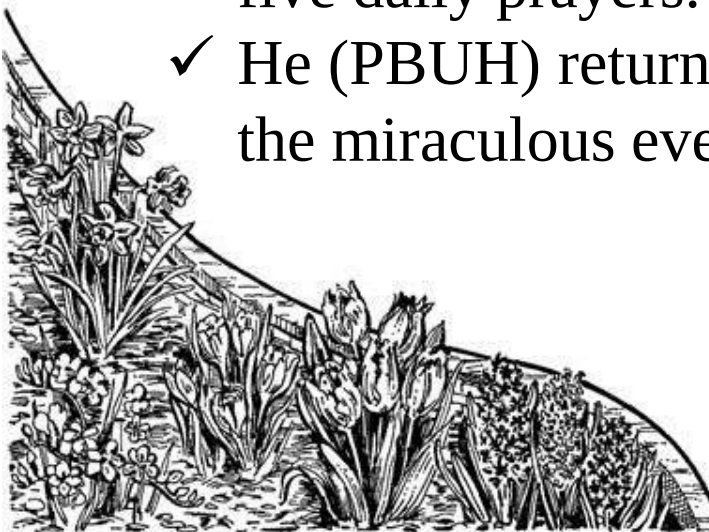


Journey to Taif

- ✓ After severe hardships in Makkah, Prophet Muhammad (PBUH) travelled to Taif with Hazrat Zaid bin Harithah (RA).
 - ✓ The people of Taif rejected his message and encouraged others to stone him.
 - ✓ Despite being badly injured, the Prophet (PBUH) showed great patience and mercy.
 - ✓ Angel Jibrail (AS) offered to punish the people of Taif, but the Prophet (PBUH) forgave them.
 - ✓ He (PBUH) hoped that their descendants would one day worship Allah.
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Mer'aj

- ✓ After the trials of Taif, Allah honored Prophet Muhammad (PBUH) with the miraculous journey of Mer'aj.
 - ✓ He (PBUH) travelled from Masjid al-Haram to Masjid al-Aqsa and then ascended through the seven heavens.
 - ✓ He (PBUH) met several earlier Prophets and witnessed Paradise and Hell.
 - ✓ At Sidrat-ul-Muntaha, he (PBUH) received the gift of the five daily prayers.
 - ✓ He (PBUH) returned to Makkah the same night and shared the miraculous event with the people.
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
