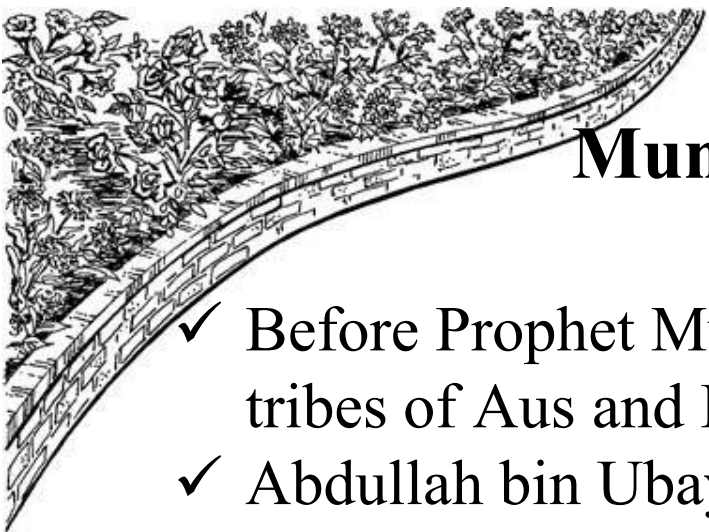
Describe the Treaty of Madinah, its significance in promoting peace, and the role of the Munafiqeen in early Madinah.



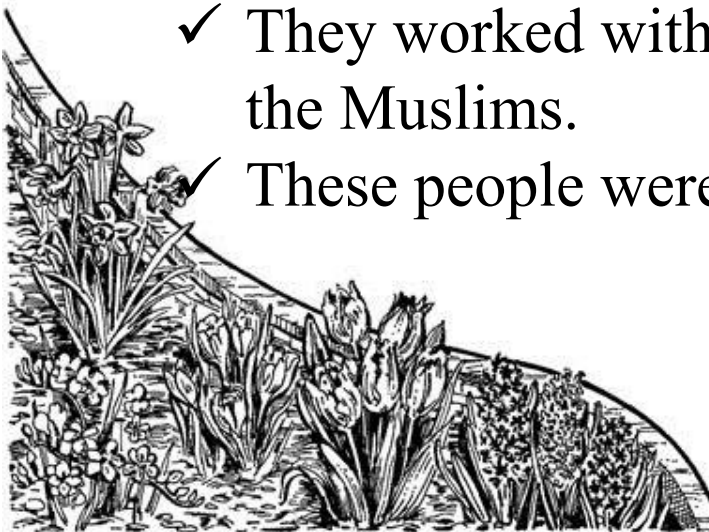


Treaty with Jews

- ✓ Prophet Muhammad (PBUH) established an agreement between the Muslims and the Jewish tribes of Madinah.
 - ✓ The main Jewish tribes were Banu Qaynuqa, Banu Nadir, and Banu Qurayza.
 - ✓ The agreement promoted peace, cooperation, and mutual defense of Madinah.
 - ✓ Everyone was given freedom to practice their religion without harassment.
 - ✓ The lives and property of the people were to be protected.
 - ✓ In serious disputes, Prophet Muhammad (PBUH) would give the final decision.

Munafiqeen (Hypocrites)

- ✓ Before Prophet Muhammad (PBUH) came to Madinah, the tribes of Aus and Khazraj often fought with each other.
 - ✓ Abdullah bin Ubay bin Sulool hoped to become the ruler of Madinah.
 - ✓ After the Prophet (PBUH) arrived, the people accepted his leadership, ending Abdullah's hopes of becoming king.
 - ✓ Abdullah and his followers outwardly accepted Islam but secretly opposed the Prophet (PBUH) and the Muslims.
 - ✓ They worked with the enemies of Islam and plotted against the Muslims.
 - ✓ These people were known as the Munafiqeen (Hypocrites).
