Battle of Uhud – Background

- ✓ After the crushing defeat at Badr, the Makkans sought revenge.
 - ✓ In 3 A.H., Abu Sufyan led 3,000 well-armed soldiers towards Madinah.
 - ✓ Prophet Muhammad (PBUH) consulted the Muslims (mushwarah) and decided to meet the enemy outside Madinah.
 - ✓ On 14 Shawwal, 3 A.H., the Prophet (PBUH) marched towards Uhud with 1,000 men.
 - ✓ Abdullah bin Ubay and 300 men deserted, leaving 700 Muslims.
 - ✓ Despite being poorly equipped, the Muslims were determined to defend the truth.
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
