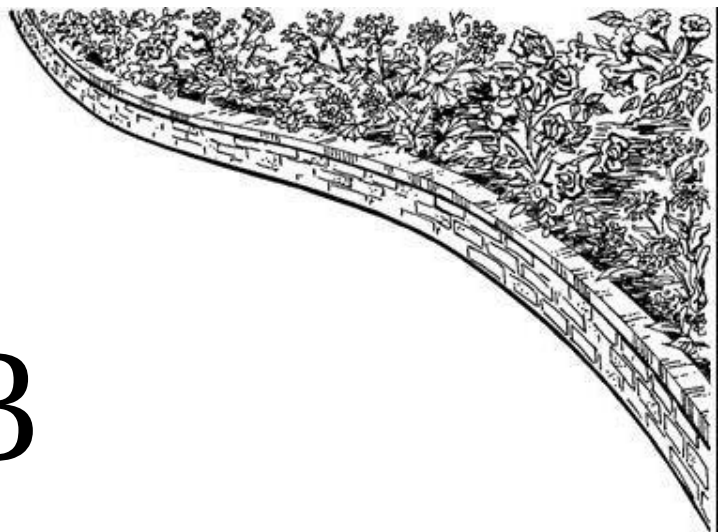

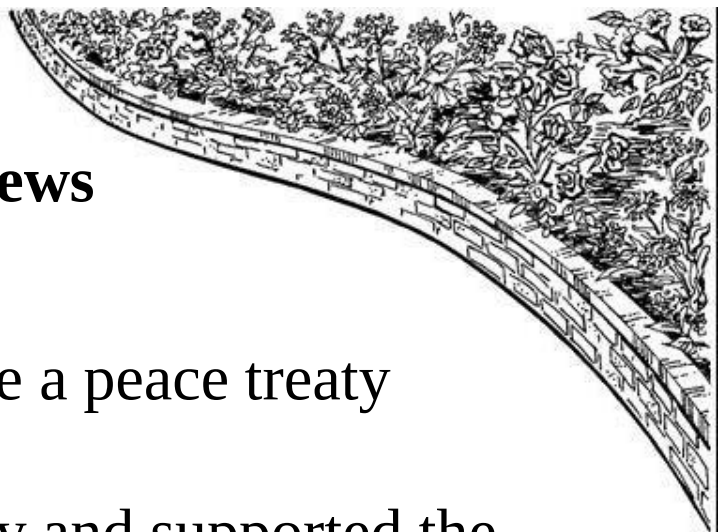
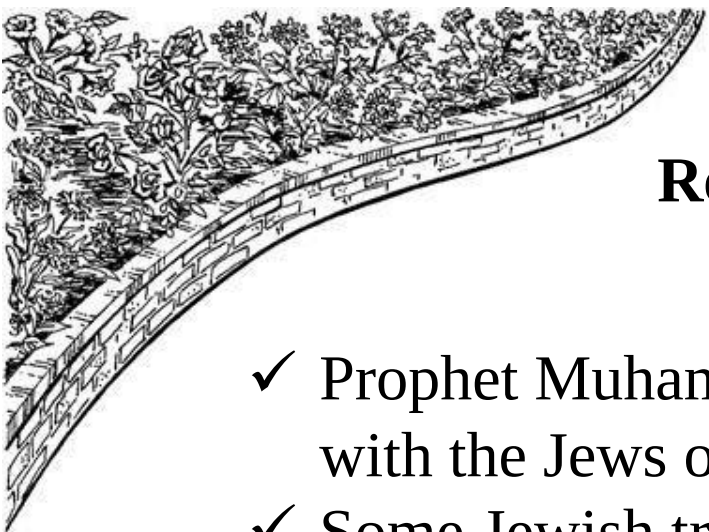
Major Battles and Milestones in the Life of Prophet Muhammad (PBUH). Madani Period



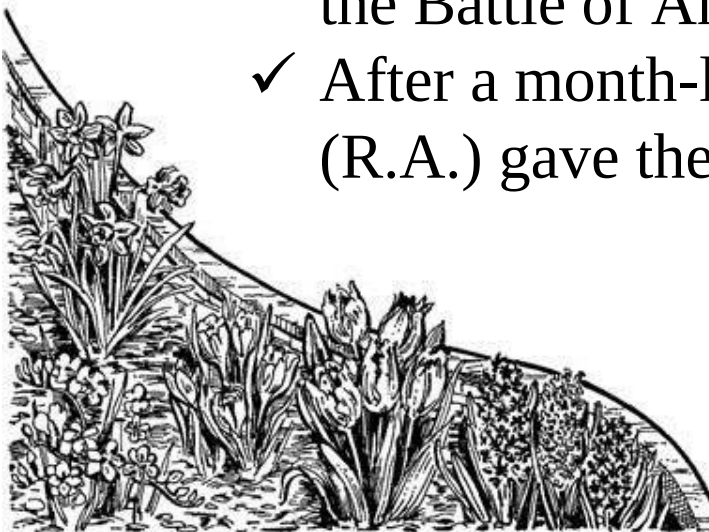
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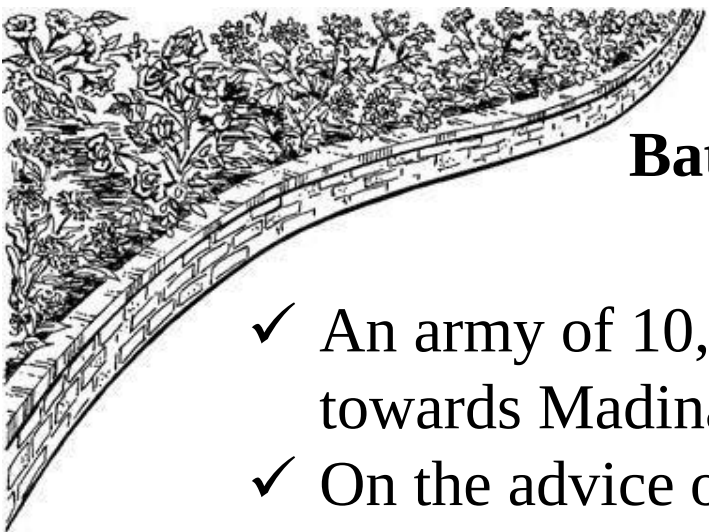

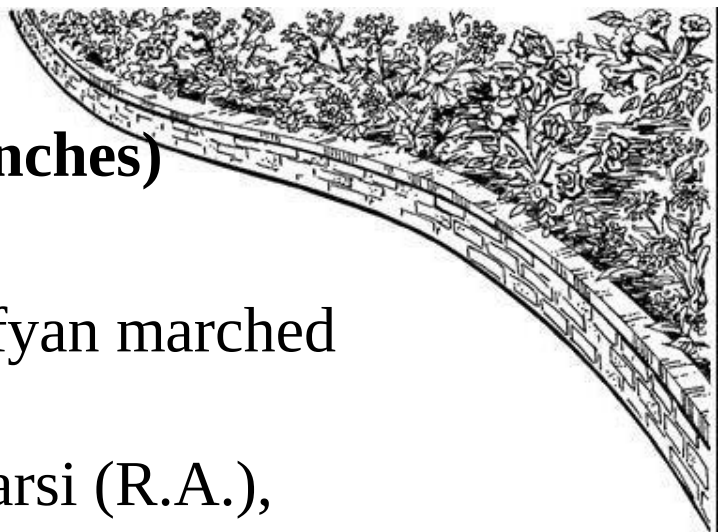


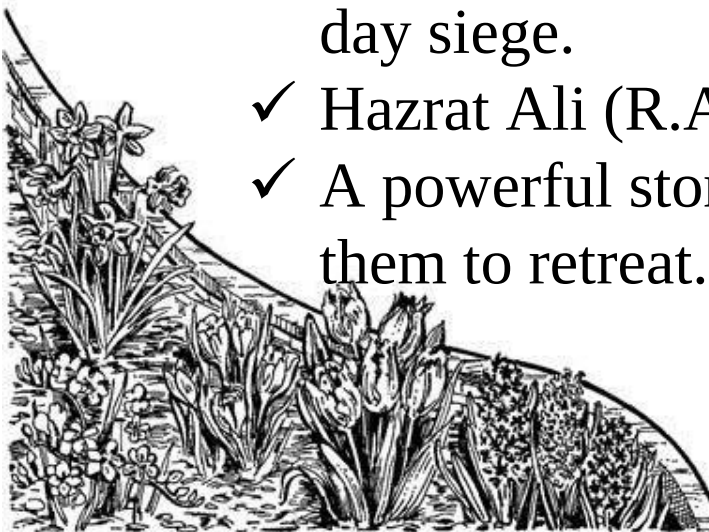
Relations with the Jews

- ✓ Prophet Muhammad (PBUH) made a peace treaty with the Jews of Madinah.
 - ✓ Some Jewish tribes broke the treaty and supported the enemies of Islam.
 - ✓ Banu Qainuqah and Banu Nadhir were expelled from Madinah.
 - ✓ In 5 A.H., Banu Quraizah joined the enemy during the Battle of Ahzab.
 - ✓ After a month-long siege, Hazrat Sa'ad bin Mu'az (R.A.) gave the final judgment.
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Battle of Ahzab (Trenches)



- ✓ An army of 10,000 led by Abu Sufyan marched towards Madinah.
 - ✓ On the advice of Hazrat Salman Farsi (R.A.), Muslims dug a deep trench around the exposed side of Madinah.
 - ✓ Prophet Muhammad (PBUH) personally worked with the Sahaba in digging the trench.
 - ✓ The enemy failed to cross the trench during the 27-day siege.
 - ✓ Hazrat Ali (R.A.) defeated the warrior Amr bin Abd.
 - ✓ A powerful storm destroyed the enemy camp, forcing them to retreat.
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
