Explain how Prophet Muhammad (PBUH) demonstrated mercy, removed idolatry, and established Tauheed during the peaceful conquest of Makkah.





Conquest of Makkah – Mercy and Triumph

- ✓ Prophet Muhammad (PBUH) granted general amnesty to the people of Makkah.
 - ✓ Even bitter enemies, including Hind bint Utbah, were forgiven and some accepted Islam.
 - ✓ The Prophet (PBUH) removed the 360 idols from the Ka‘bah.
 - ✓ He (PBUH) restored the Ka‘bah to the worship of One Allah (Tauheed).
 - ✓ The conquest demonstrated his mercy, forgiveness, patience and faith.
 - ✓ Prophet Muhammad (PBUH) returned to Madinah after staying in Makkah for about 10–15 days.
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
