March on Tabook

- ✓ The Romans saw the rapid spread of Islam as a threat.
 - ✓ News reached Madinah of a Roman army preparing to attack.
 - ✓ Prophet Muhammad (PBUH) gathered an army of 30,000 Muslims.
 - ✓ Hazrat Usman (R.A.) donated 3,000 camels and 10,000 dinars.
 - ✓ The Muslim army marched to Tabook in Rajab 9 A.H.
 - ✓ The Muslims stayed at Tabook for 20 days.
 - ✓ The Romans withdrew and did not fight the Muslim army.
 - ✓ Peace agreements were made with several Christian tribes.
 - ✓ The Prophet Muhammad (PBUH) returned safely to Madinah.
 - ✓ The expedition strengthened Islam and helped unite Arabia.
