The Farewell hajj

- ✓ The Prophet Muhammad (PBUH) performed his only Hajj in 10 A.H.
 - ✓ He (PBUH) traveled from Madinah to Makkah with about 124,000 companions.
 - ✓ At Arafat, he (PBUH) delivered the historic Farewell Sermon.
 - ✓ He (PBUH) emphasized equality, justice, women's rights, and respect.
 - ✓ He (PBUH) declared Riba (interest) forbidden.
 - ✓ The Prophet (PBUH) asked if he (PBUH) had conveyed Allah's message.
 - ✓ He (PBUH) emphasized following the Quran and Sunnah.
 - ✓ The final revelation declared Islam a perfected religion.
 - ✓ After completing Hajj, he (PBUH) returned to Madinah.
 - ✓ The Farewell Hajj became a symbol of unity and equality.
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
