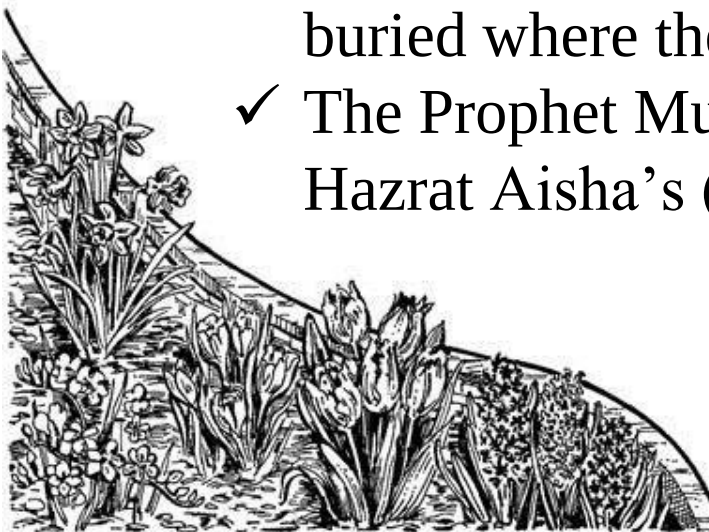


The Final days and passing of Prophet Muhammad (PBUH)

- ✓ The Prophet's (PBUH) final illness began with a severe headache and fever.
 - ✓ Despite his illness, he continued to fulfill his responsibilities.
 - ✓ Later, he stayed in Hazrat Aisha's (R.A.) chamber with the permission of his wives.
 - ✓ On Monday morning, he watched the Muslims praying Fajr behind Hazrat Abu Bakr (R.A.).
 - ✓ He (PBUH) passed away later that day in Hazrat Aisha's (R.A.) chamber.
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The Final days and passing of Prophet Muhammad (PBUH)

- ✓ During his final moments, Hazrat Aisha (R.A.) cared for and supported him.
 - ✓ The Prophet Muhammad (PBUH) suffered from intense fever and weakness.
 - ✓ After his passing, the companions disagreed about where to bury him.
 - ✓ Hazrat Abu Bakr (R.A.) reminded them that Prophets are buried where they pass away.
 - ✓ The Prophet Muhammad (PBUH) was therefore buried in Hazrat Aisha's (R.A.) chamber.
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
