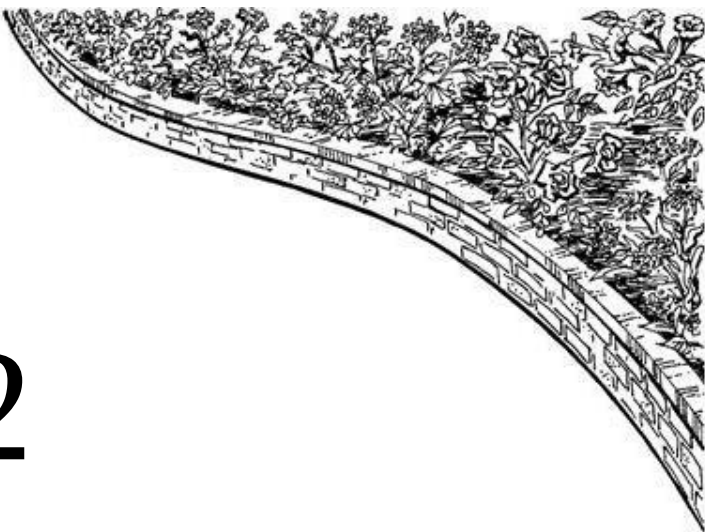

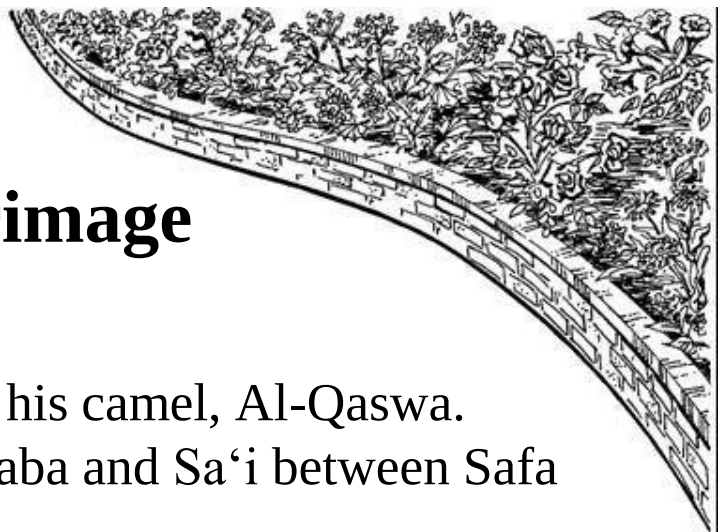
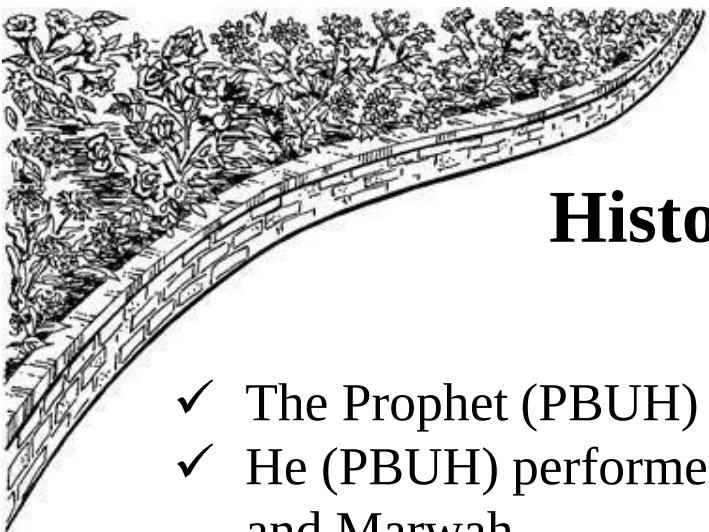
The Farewell Hajj (pilgrimage) & The Last Sermon



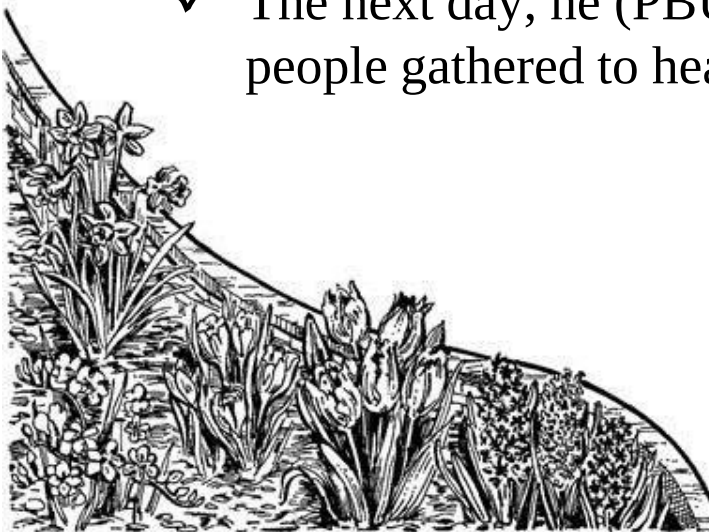

Explain the sequence of Prophet Muhammad's (PBUH) Farewell Pilgrimage rituals, including Ihram, Tawaf, Sa'i, Hadi, and prayers, and the guidance he (PBUH) gave to his Companions.





History of Last Pilgrimage

- ✓ The Prophet (PBUH) entered Makkah riding his camel, Al-Qaswa.
 - ✓ He (PBUH) performed Tawaf around the Kaaba and Sa'i between Safa and Marwah.
 - ✓ He (PBUH) remained in Ihram because he (PBUH) intended to perform both Umrah and Hajj.
 - ✓ Companions without sacrificial animals were instructed to complete Umrah and leave Ihram.
 - ✓ On 8th Dhul-Hijjah, the Prophet (PBUH) traveled to Mina.
 - ✓ The next day, he (PBUH) proceeded to Arafat, where about 124,000 people gathered to hear him.
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
