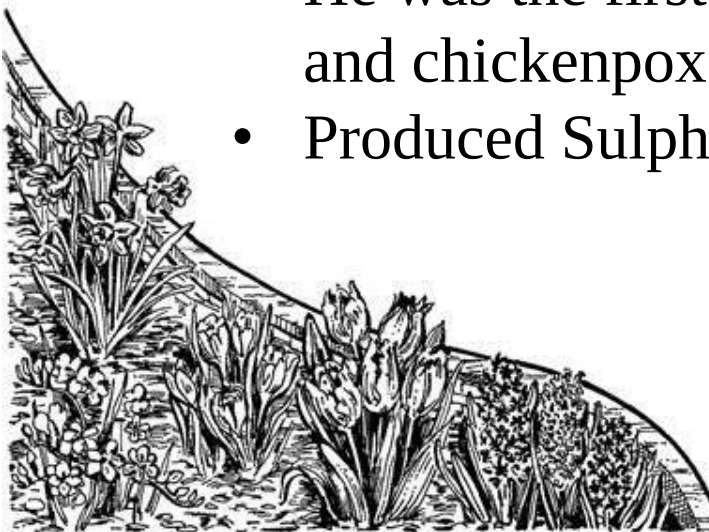




Al-Razi



Al-Razi (864–930 C.E.) Rhazes

- He made major contributions to Medicine, Chemistry, Mathematics, Astronomy, and Philosophy.
 - His famous books include Al-Hawi, Kitab al-Mansoori and Kitab Al Judari.
 - A Great Psychologist
 - Introduced opium for anesthesia
 - He was the first to clearly distinguish between smallpox and chickenpox.
 - Produced Sulphuric acid
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
