Ibn Rushd (Averroes)

- **Ibn Rushd (1128-1198 CE) Averroes**
 - Contributed to Philosophy, Logic, Medicine, Astronomy, and Jurisprudence
 - Wrote Kitab al-Kulyat fi al-Tibb on Medicine
 - Wrote Tuhafut al-Tuhafut in response to Al-Ghazali
 - In Astronomy Kitab fi-Harakat al-Falak.
 - Wrote about the motion of celestial spheres
 - Authored Hidayat-al-Mujtahid wa-Nihayat-al-Muqtasid on Islamic jurisprudence
 - His works strongly influenced European philosophy and helped spread Aristotle's ideas.
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
