Ibn Sina (Avecenna)

- Ibn-e Cina (980-1037 CE) Avecenna
 - Famous physician, philosopher, mathematician, and astronomer
 - ***Wrote Al-Qanoon fi al-Tibb***, known as the Canon of Medicine
 - Described 760 medicines and their uses
 - Studied contagious diseases, tuberculosis, and meningitis
 - Made important contributions to Anatomy, Gynecology, and child health
 - ***Wrote Kitab al-Shifa***, a major philosophical and scientific encyclopedia
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
