Abu Al-Nasr Al-Farabi

- Abu al-Nasar al Farabi (870-950 CE)
 - Famous philosopher, scientist, and encyclopedist
 - Contributed to Philosophy, Logic, Sociology, Psychology, Medicine, Mathematics, and Music
 - ***Known as the “Second Teacher” (al-Muallam al-Sani)*** after Aristotle
 - Made the study of Logic easier by dividing it into idea and proof
 - An expert in linguistics
 - ***Wrote Ara Ahl al-Madina al-Fadila*** on Sociology
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
