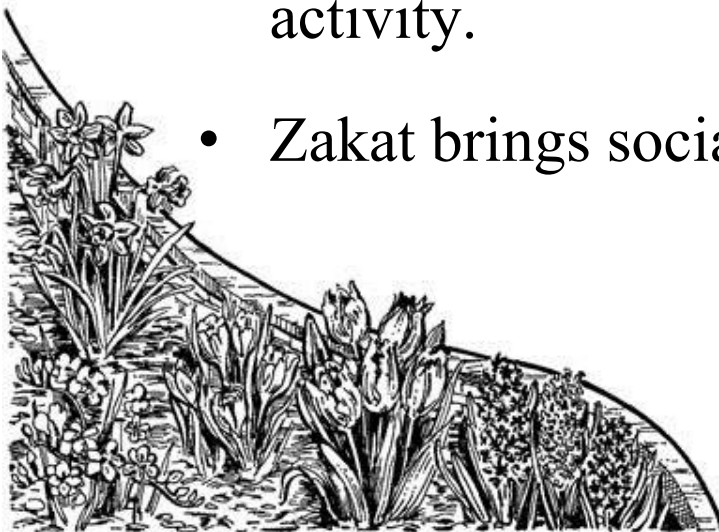


Benefits of Zakat

- Reminds Muslims that wealth is a blessing from Allah.
 - Helps fulfill the needs of the poor and needy.
 - Acts as a form of social security in society.
 - Develops gratitude, generosity, and social responsibility.
 - Strengthens the relationship between the rich and poor.
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Benefits of Zakat

- Zakat discourages hoarding of wealth.
 - Encourages the circulation and investment of money.
 - Redistributes wealth among different sections of society.
 - Increases the purchasing power of the poor.
 - Helps increase demand, production, and economic activity.
 - Zakat brings social welfare and economic balance.
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
