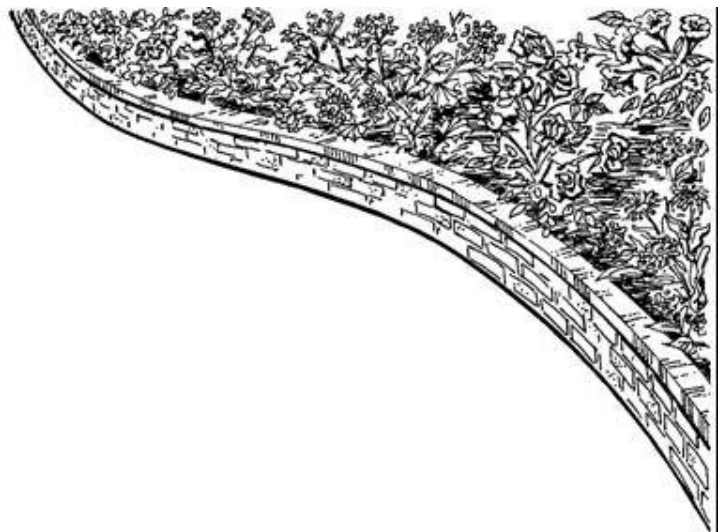

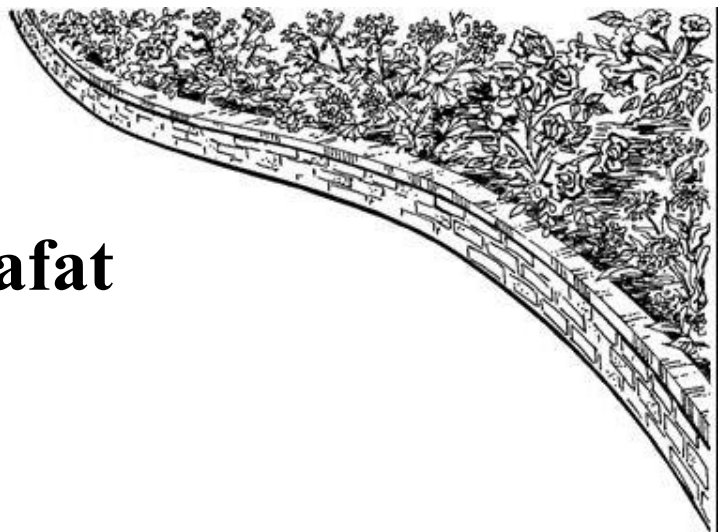
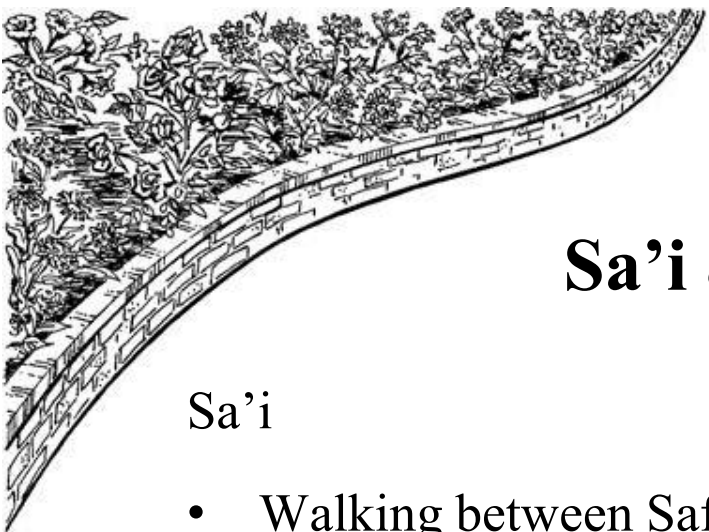
Pillars of Islam: The pilgrimage

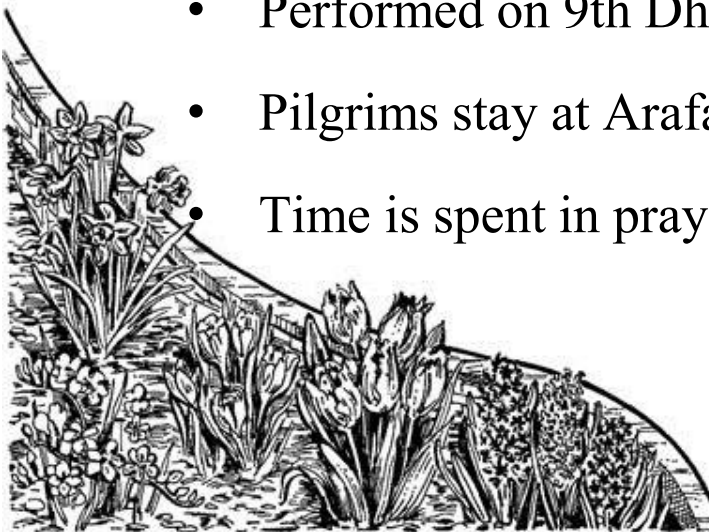


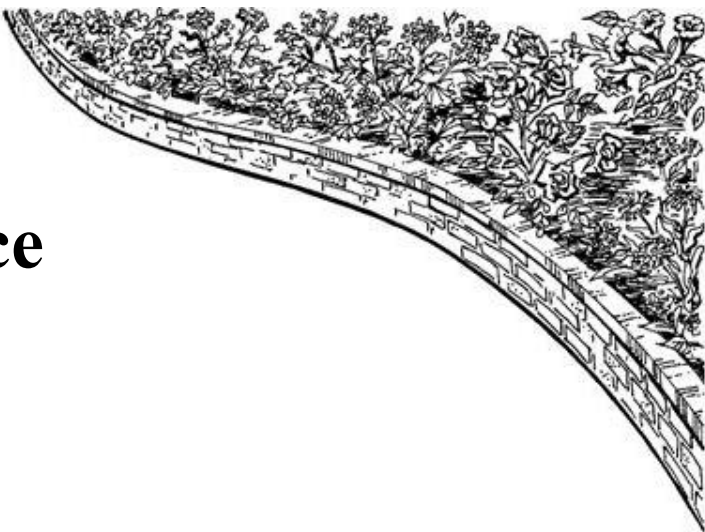
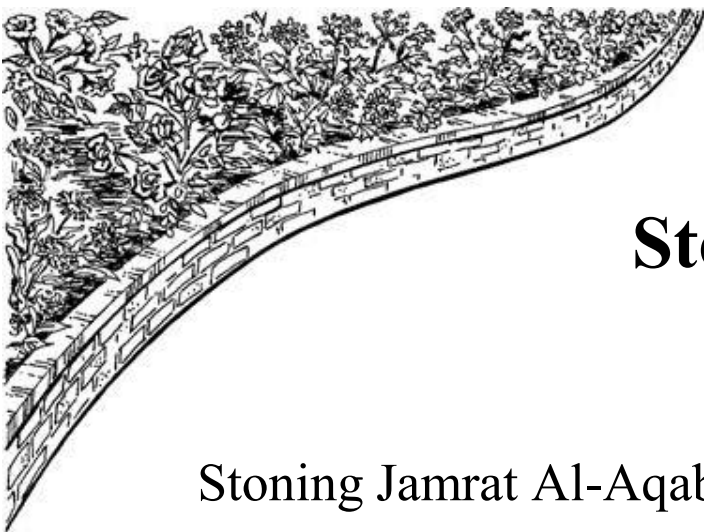
Sa'i & Wuquf at Arafat

Sa'i

- Walking between Safa and Marwah.
- Remembers Hajar (AS) searching for water.
- Symbolizes struggle and patience.

Wuquf at Arafat

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- Performed on 9th Dhul-Hijjah.
 - Pilgrims stay at Arafat until sunset.
 - Time is spent in prayer and supplication.

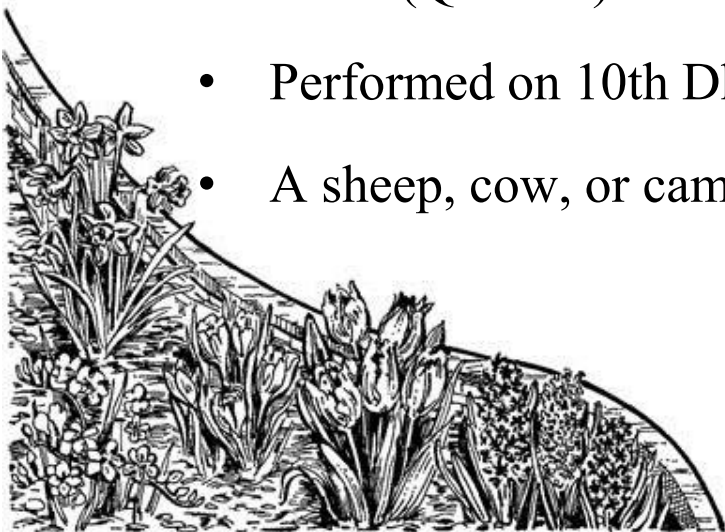


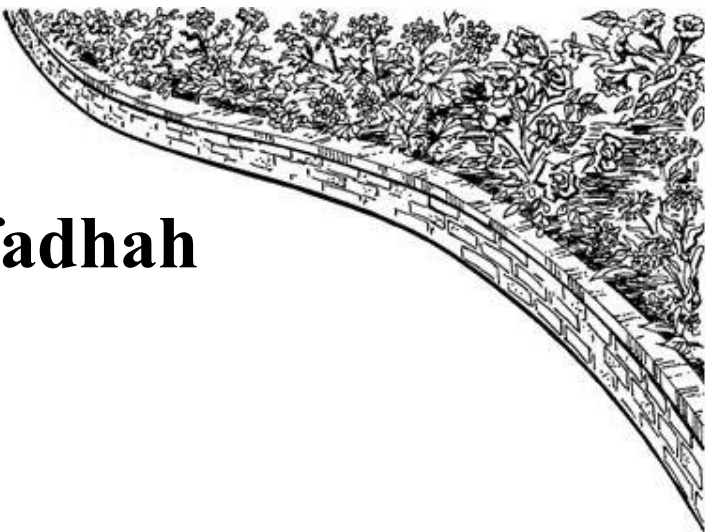
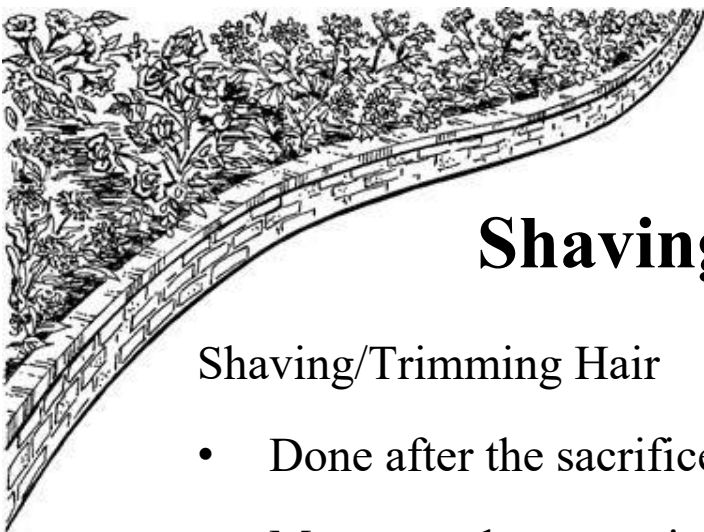
Stoning & Sacrifice

Stoning Jamrat Al-Aqabah

- Performed at Mina.
- 7 small pebbles are thrown.
- “Allah-u-Akbar” is said with each throw.

Sacrifice (Qurbani)

- Performed on 10th Dhul-Hijjah.
 - A sheep, cow, or camel may be sacrificed.
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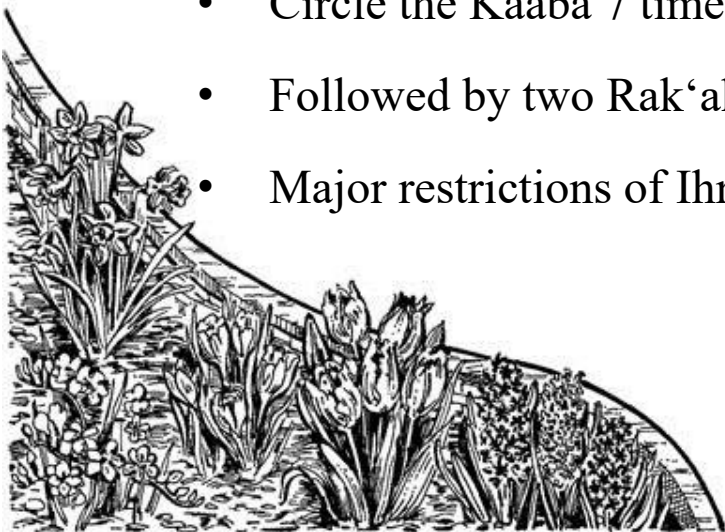


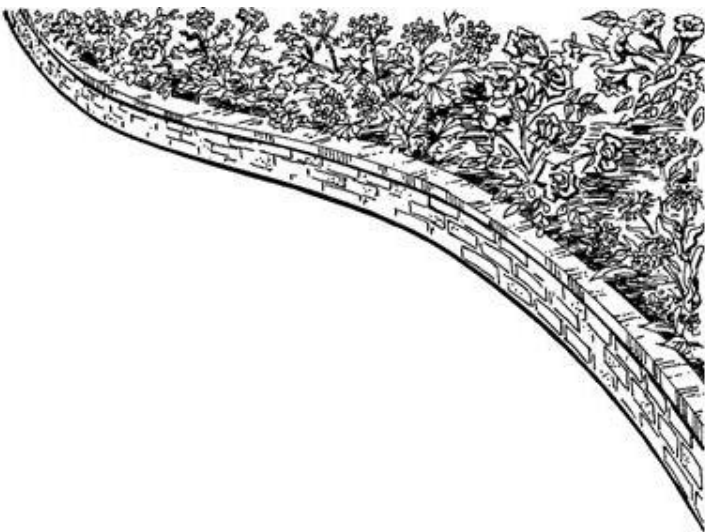
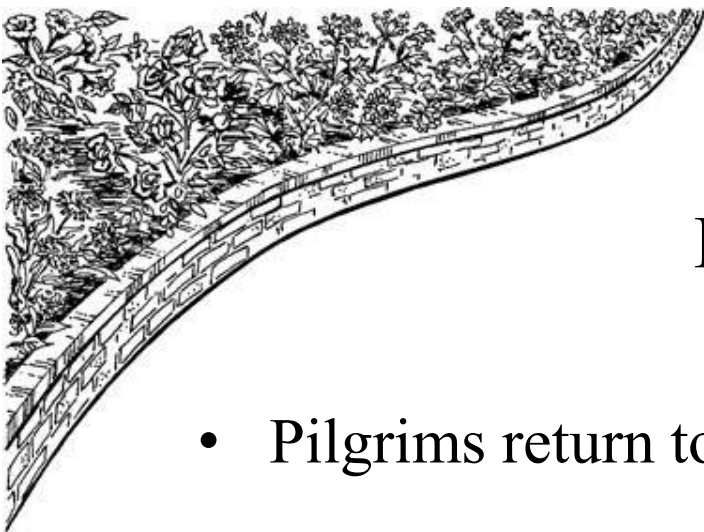
Shaving & Tawaf Al-Ifadhah

Shaving/Trimming Hair

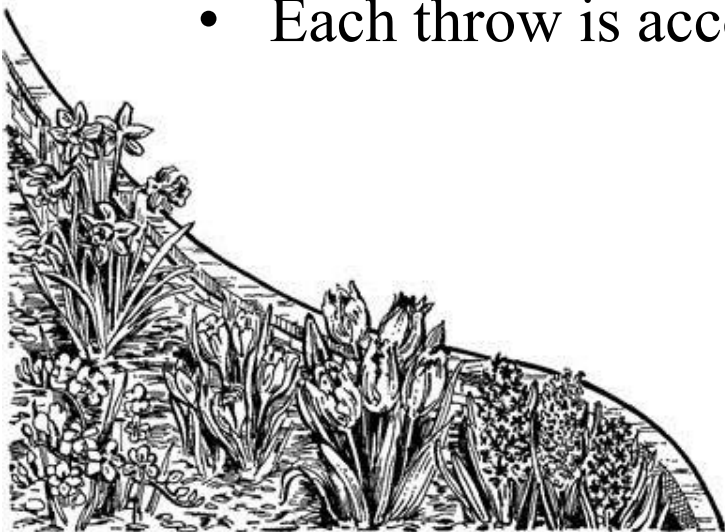
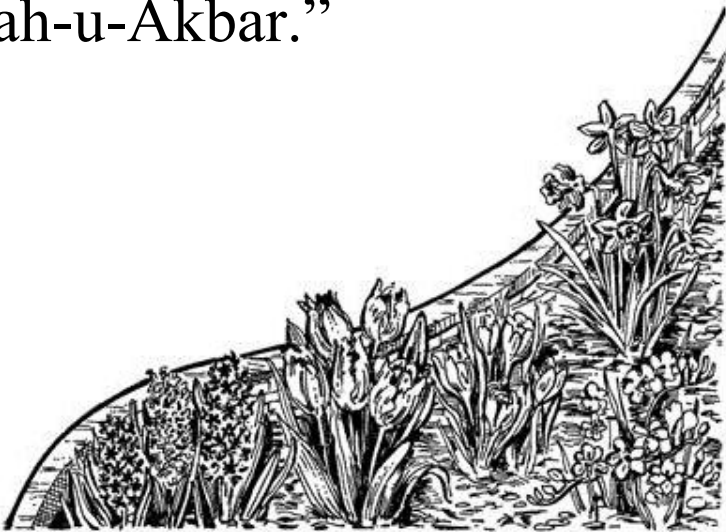
- Done after the sacrifice.
- Men may shave or trim their hair.
- Shaving is considered preferable.
- Women trim a small portion of their hair.

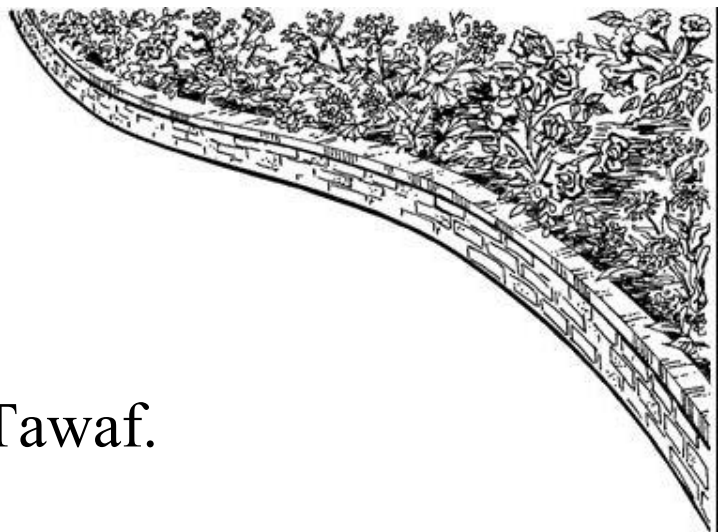
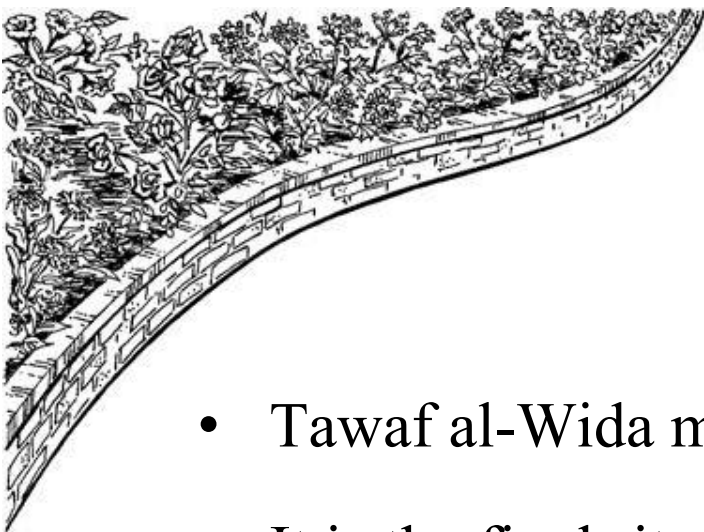
Tawaf Al-Ifadhah

- Circle the Kaaba 7 times.
 - Followed by two Rak'ahs and Sa'i.
 - Major restrictions of Ihram end afterward.
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Return to Mina

- Pilgrims return to Mina.
 - Stay during the Days of Tashreeq.
 - Stone the three Jamarat each day.
 - 7 pebbles are thrown at each Jamarah.
 - Each throw is accompanied by “Allah-u-Akbar.”
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Tawaf al-Wida

- Tawaf al-Wida means the Farewell Tawaf.
 - It is the final rite of Hajj.
 - Pilgrims circle the Kaaba before leaving Makkah.
 - Menstruating women are excused from this Tawaf.
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
