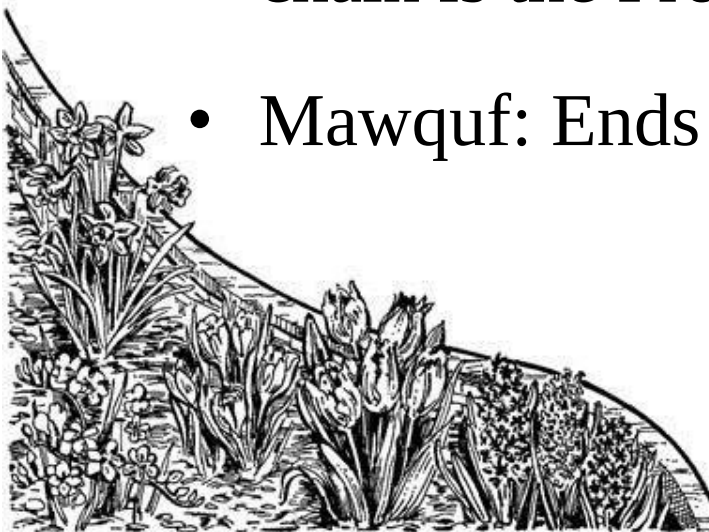


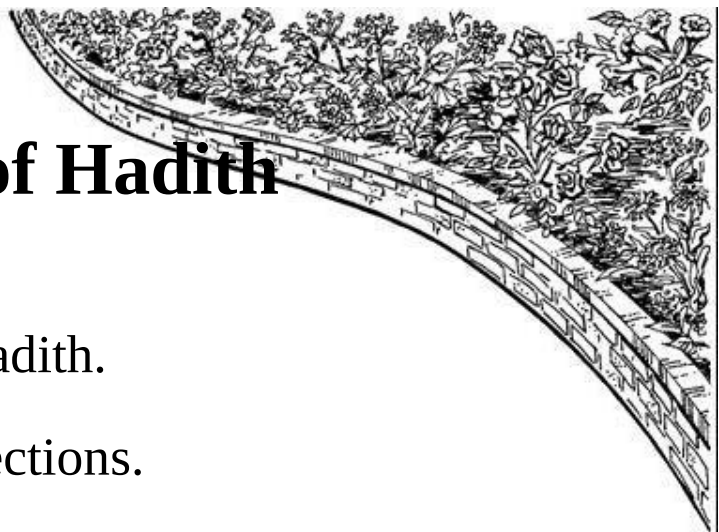
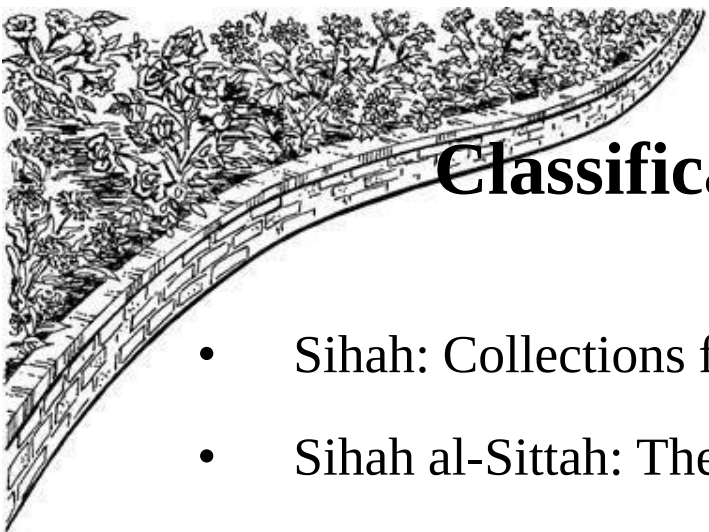
## Da'eef Hadith

- Da'eef means weak.
  - It has a problem in the chain or narrators.
  - A narrator may have poor memory or questionable reliability.
  - The chain may also be disconnected.
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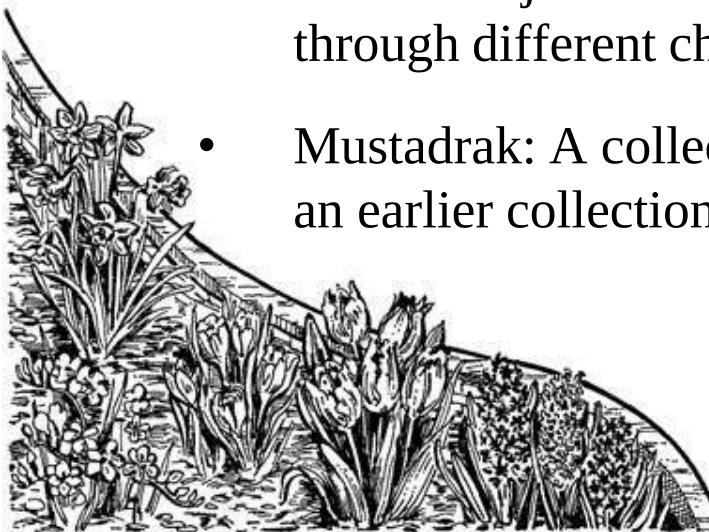


## Types of Hadith Based on Chain

- Musnad: Complete chain reaching a Companion who reports from the Prophet (PBUH).
  - Muttasil: Continuous and uninterrupted chain.
  - Marfu': The doer or speaker at the end of the chain is the Prophet (PBUH).
  - Mawquf: Ends with a Companion.
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# Classification of Books of Hadith

- Sihah: Collections focused on authentic Hadith.
  - Sihah al-Sittah: The six major Hadith collections.
  - Jami': Collections covering different areas of Islam, such as beliefs, worship, manners, and history.
  - Sunan: Collections mainly arranged according to Islamic legal topics.
  - Mustakhraj: A collection that narrates Hadith from an existing book through different chains of transmission.
  - Mustadrak: A collection that adds Hadith meeting the conditions of an earlier collection but not included by its original author.
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
