فلا و ربك لا يومنون حتى يحكموك فيما شجر بينهم



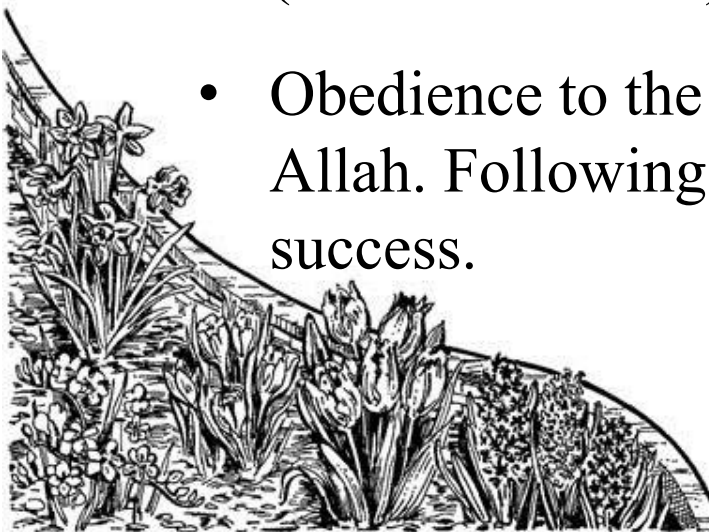


Quran & Sunnah

- Quran and Sunnah are complementary.
 - Quran gives general guidance.
 - Sunnah explains and clarifies it.
 - Both are primary sources of Shariah.
 - “Whatever the Messenger gives you, take it...”
 - (Al-Hashr 59:7)
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Following the Prophet (PBUH)

- The Sunnah gives a practical example of Islam.
 - Muslims are commanded to obey Allah and His Messenger ﷺ.
 - “In the Messenger of Allah you have an excellent example.”
 - (Al-Ahzab 33:21)
 - Obedience to the Messenger (PBUH) is obedience to Allah. Following Allah and His Messenger leads to success.
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
