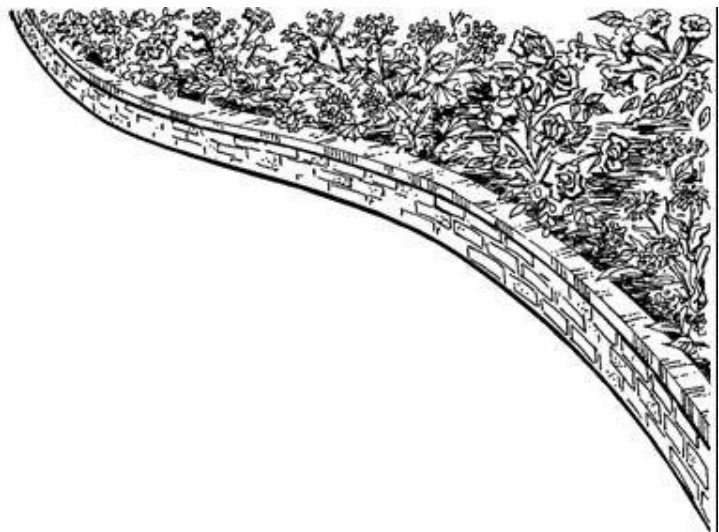

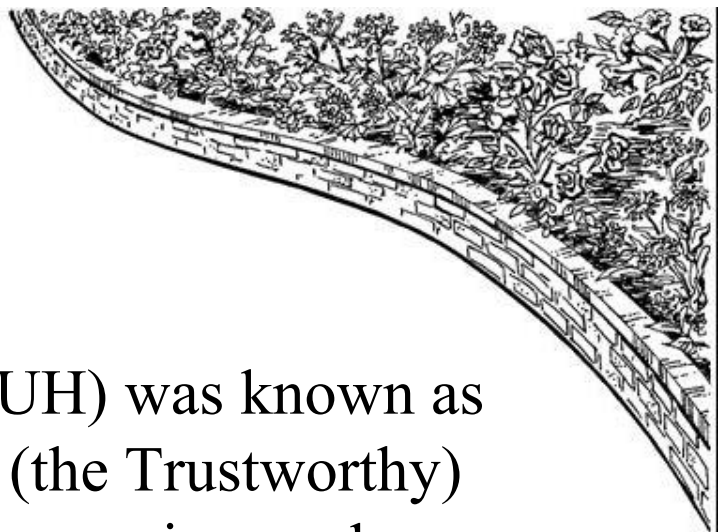
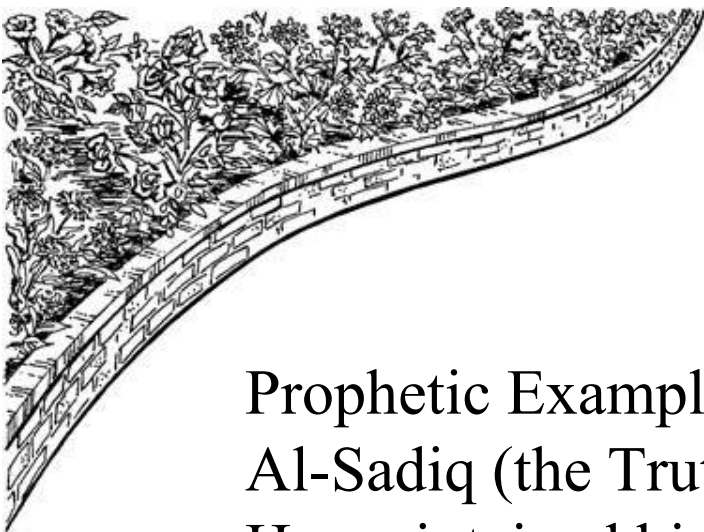
Sincerity, Fulfilling Promise & Truthfulness

Distinguishing the impact of fulfilling versus breaking promises to analyze their significance in personal integrity and societal trust.

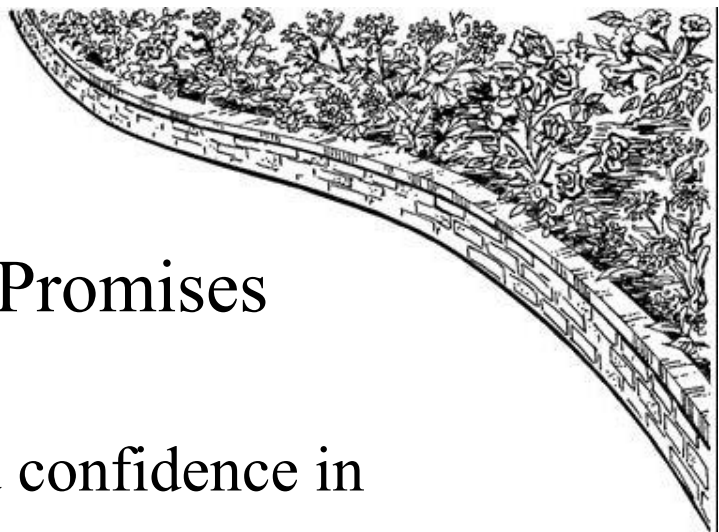
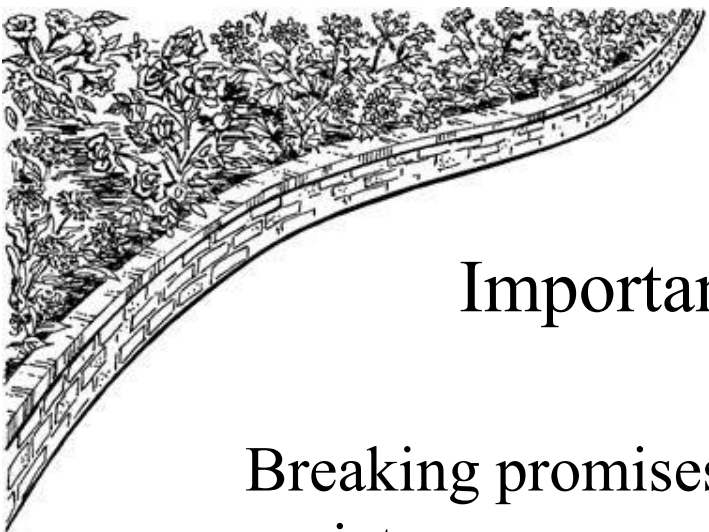




Examples

Prophetic Example: The Prophet (PBUH) was known as Al-Sadiq (the Truthful) and Al-Amin (the Trustworthy). He maintained his integrity even with enemies, such as when he guaranteed the safety of Safwan bin Umayyah or refused to breach a contract with the messenger Abu Rafe.
