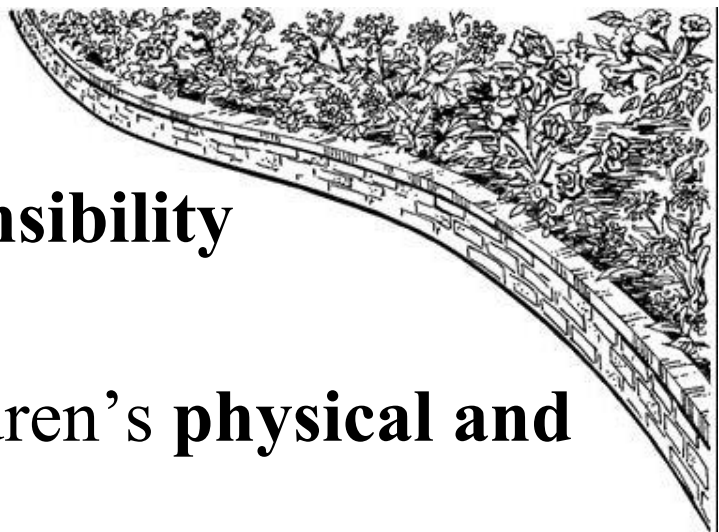
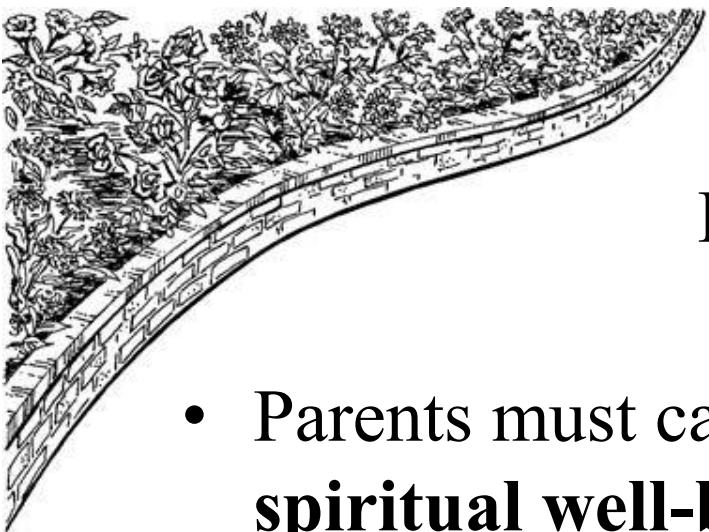
Rights of Parents and Children



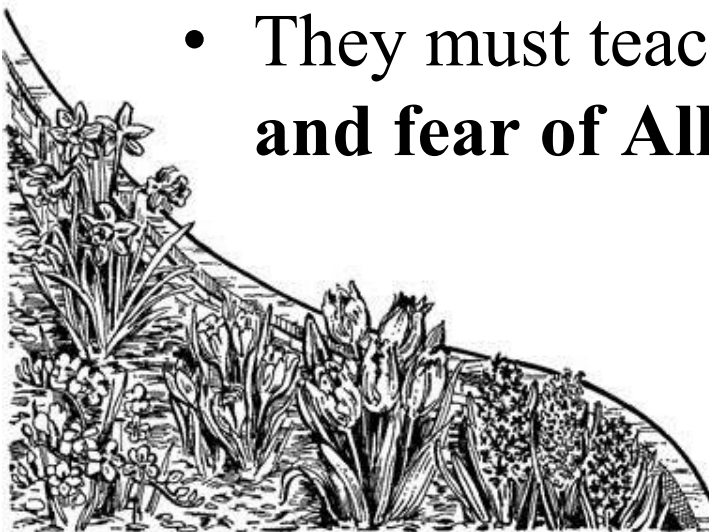
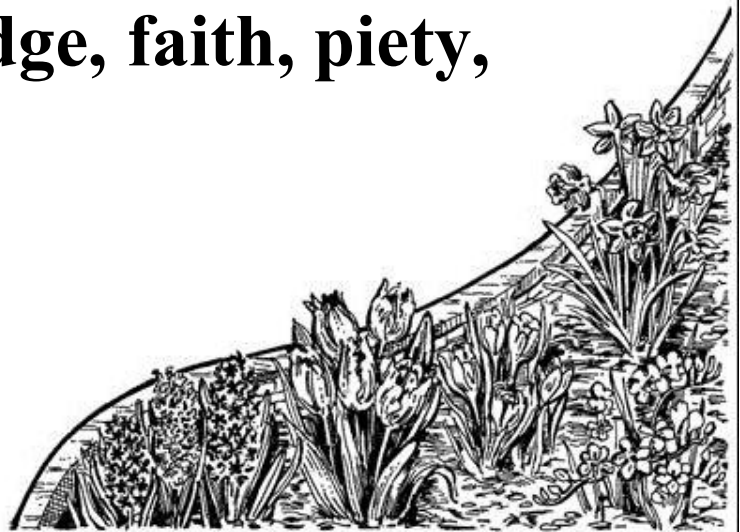
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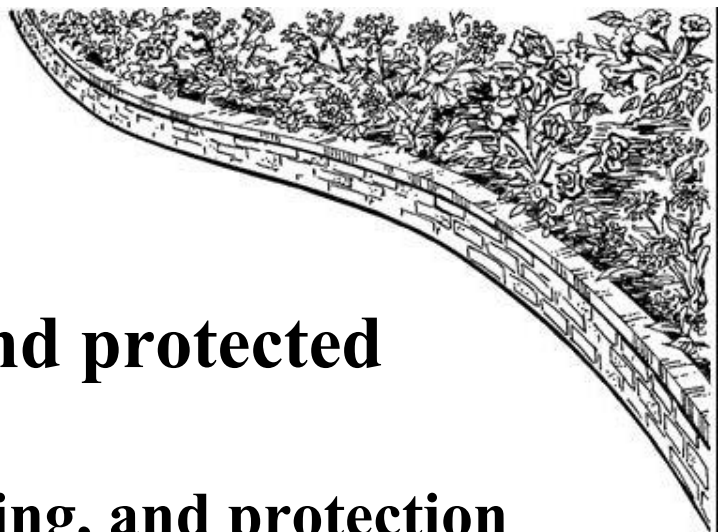
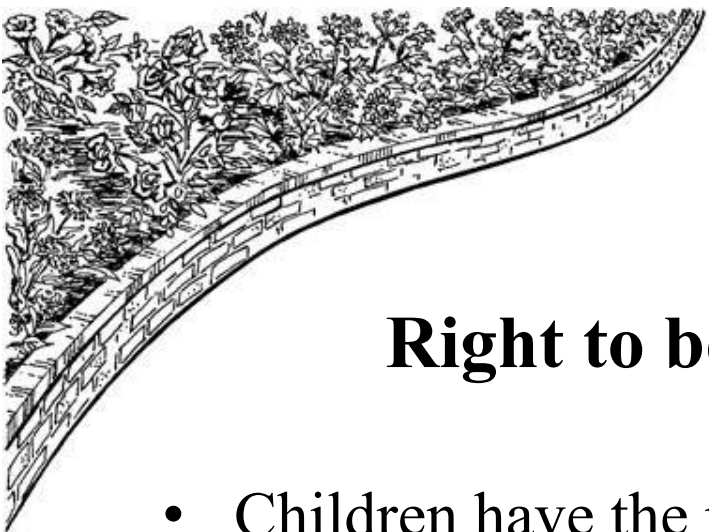
Explaining the rights of children to care and protection, and analyze the corresponding duties of parents in ensuring moral, intellectual, and physical well-being.



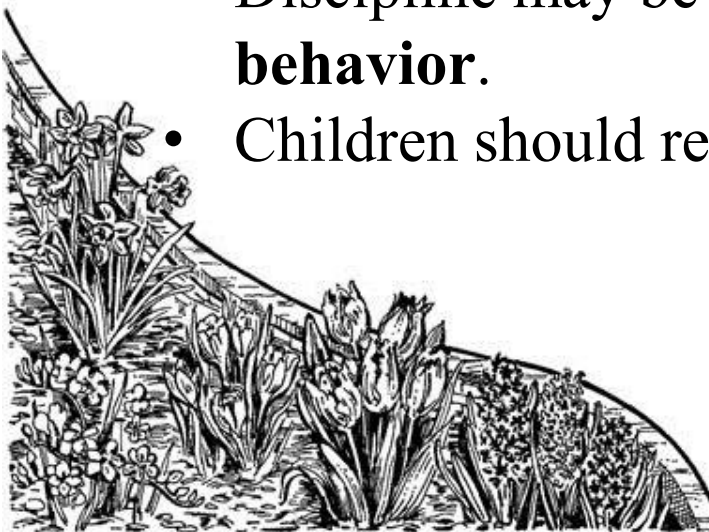


Parents' Responsibility

- Parents must care for their children's **physical and spiritual well-being**.
 - They should provide **food, clothing, safety, and protection**.
 - Parents should guide children toward **good company and good actions**.
 - They must teach them **knowledge, faith, piety, and fear of Allah**.
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Right to be fed, clothed and protected

- Children have the right to **food, clothing, and protection** until adulthood.
 - Parents must protect them from **physical, moral, and intellectual harm**.
 - Parents should support their **overall development**.
 - Discipline may be used to prevent **harmful or undesirable behavior**.
 - Children should respond with **respect and obedience**.
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
