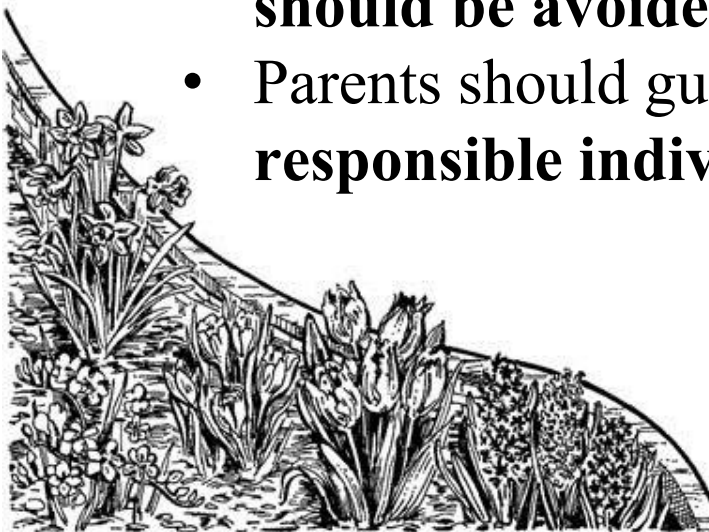
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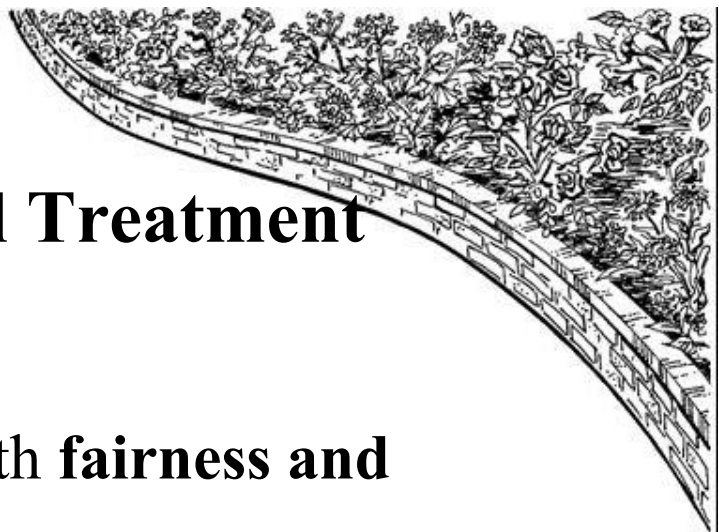
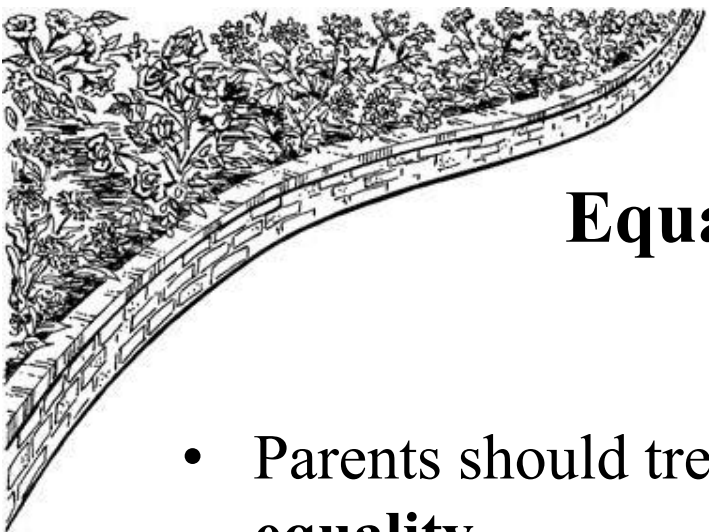
Explaining children's psychological needs, affection, fairness, and material provision according to Islamic teachings.





Children's Psychological Needs

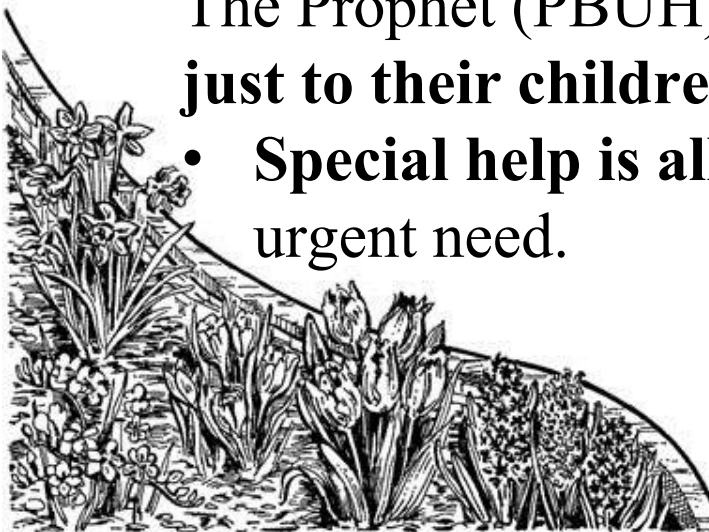
- Children need **love, affection, hugs, kisses, and kindness.**
 - The Prophet (PBUH) showed great **love and compassion toward children.**
 - Love and gentle treatment can be more effective than **fear and harshness.**
 - Discipline may be used when needed, but **over-protection should be avoided.**
 - Parents should guide children toward becoming **responsible individuals.**
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Equality in Parental Treatment

- Parents should treat their children with **fairness and equality**.
- No child should receive **unfair preference in gifts or privileges**.
- Favoritism can create **jealousy, hatred, and conflict** among siblings.

The Prophet (PBUH) instructed parents to **fear Allah and be just to their children**.

- **Special help is allowed** when a child has a genuine or urgent need.
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
