Ethics and Morality: The Quran provides moral and ethical guidelines for personal conduct, social justice, and interactions with others.

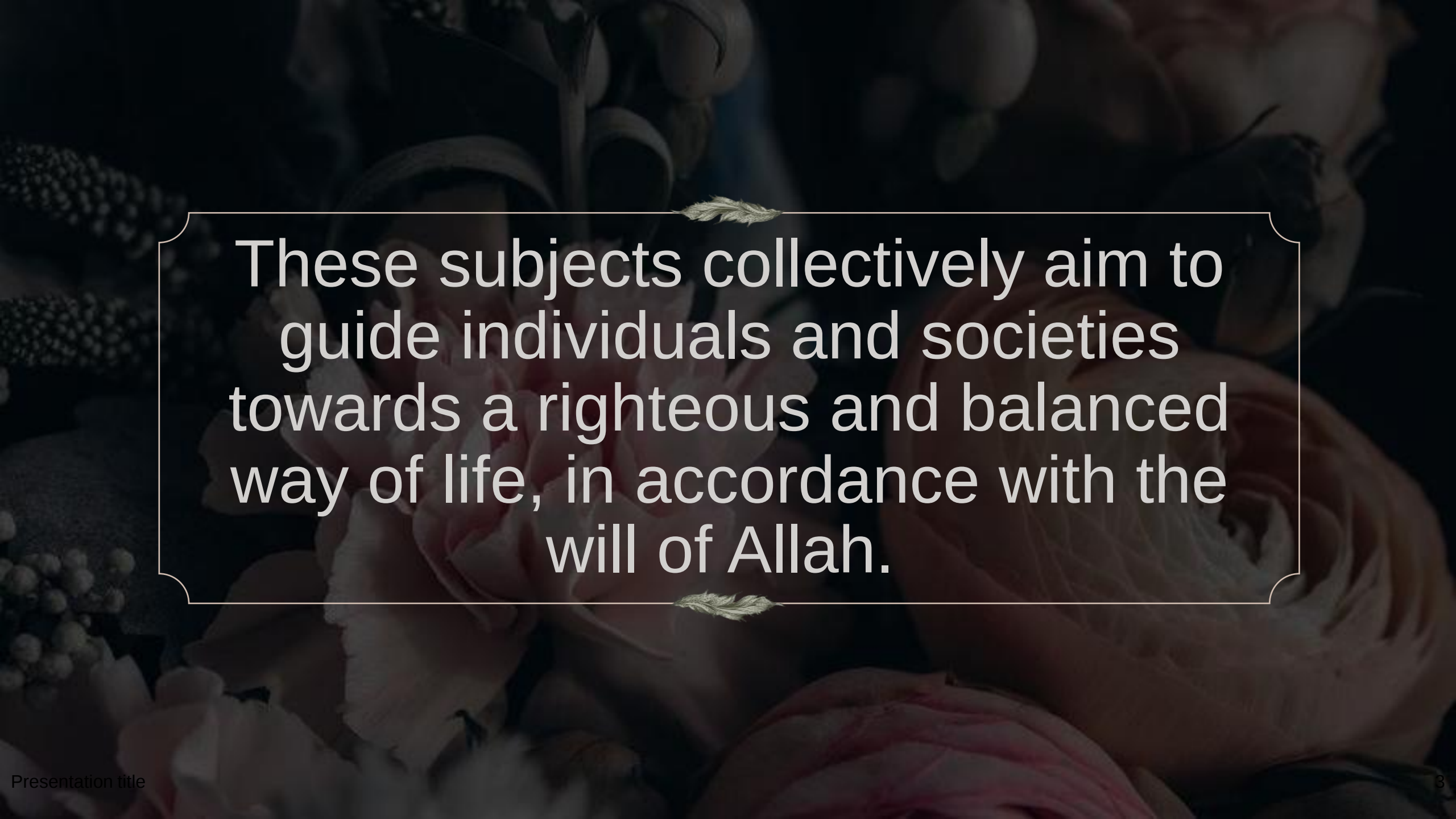
Law (Sharia): It includes legal principles and laws governing various aspects of life, such as marriage, inheritance, and criminal justice.

Human Relationships: It provides guidance on family life, community relations, and the treatment of others.

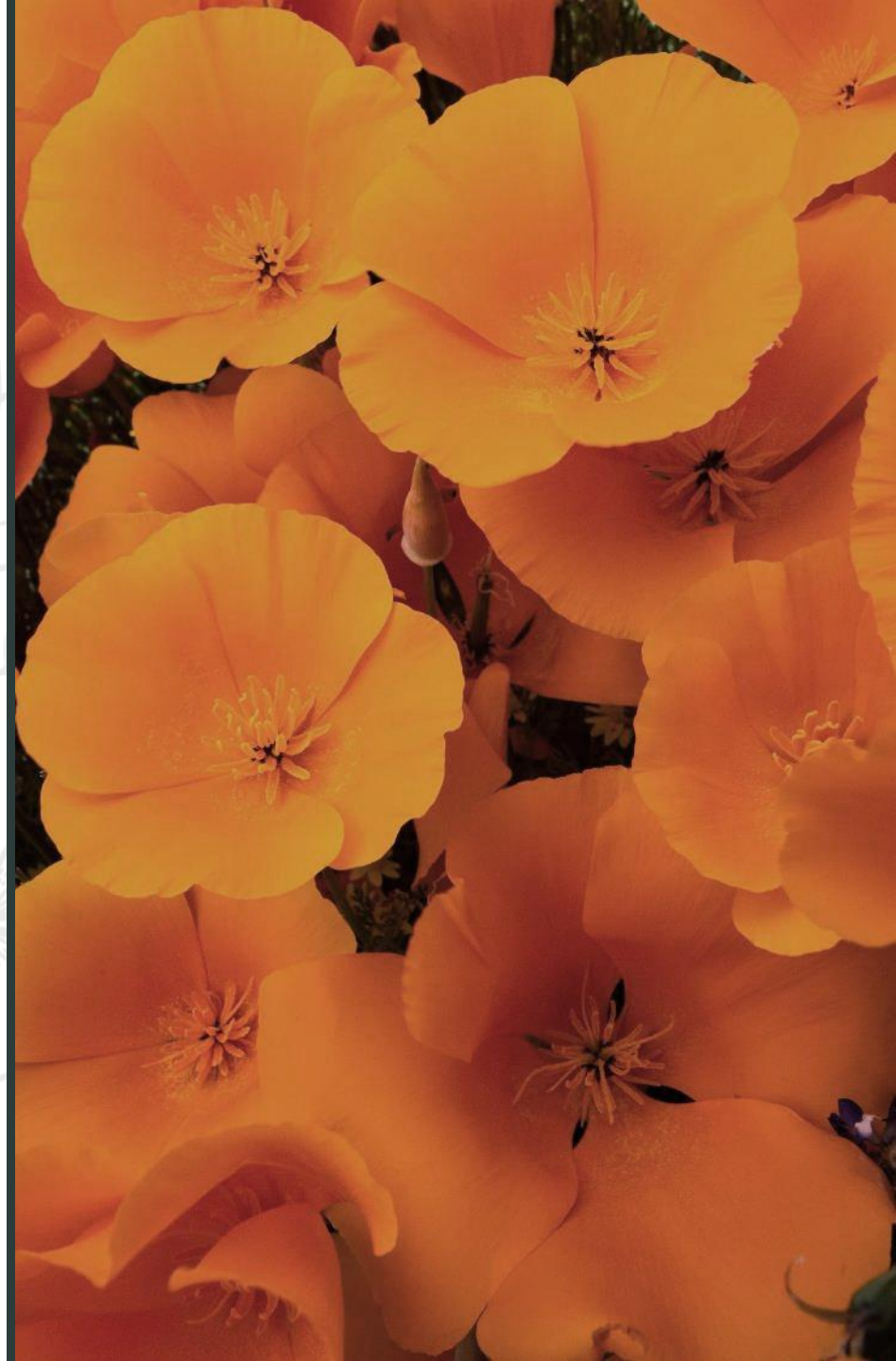

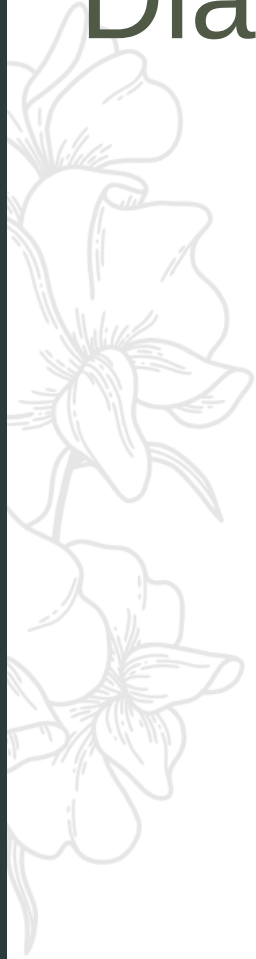
